NOTICE FOR ACTUAL USERS OF 'OTHER WASTES' DEFINED IN HAZARDOUS & OTHER WASTE (M&TM) RULES, 2016, TO OBTAIN AUTHORIZATION

It is for the information of all the concerned that the Government of India, Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, has notified the Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016 vide notification no. G.S.R No. 395 (E) on 04th April, 2016 in supersession of Hazardous Waste (MH&TM) Rules, 2008.

Where all the industries and stake holders covered under the provisions of Rule 9 of the said rules were directed through public notice dated 22.08.2017 to apply for obtaining the necessary authorization from this Board for utilization of Hazardous & Other Waste under Hazardous and Other Wastes (M&TM) Rules, 2016.

Whereas, all the industries and stake holders engaged and involved in utilization of other wastes, mentioned in Schedule III of Hazardous and Other Wastes (M&TM) Rules, 2016, as a resource or after pre-processing either for co-processing or for any other use, including within the premises of the generator (if it is not a part of process) and has not obtained the authorization or approval from the authority, prescribed under Rule 6 & 9 of these Rules, are granted 03 months more time to such actual user units of 'other wastes' where Standard Operating Procedure or Guidelines are not available, to obtain approval from Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) for utilization of such 'other wastes' and one month time for obtaining specific authorization for utilization of such 'Other Wastes' from this Board after issue of Standard Operating Procedure or Guidelines by CPCB or where Standards Operating Procedures or Guidelines are available. Such actual user units of 'Other Wastes' are directed to apply within 15 days to the CPCB for obtaining approval for utilization of 'Other Wastes' as per provision of Rule 9 of the HOWM Rules, 2016.

Whereas, whosoever fails to obtain the approval from CPCB and authorization from Haryana State Pollution Control Board within the prescribed time shall be liable to face legal action under the provision of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986
