After examination in pursuance to the query of the Hon'ble Members of the Board, it has been found that 02 cases were filed by Regional Office Gurugram (South) under EP Act and in both cases accused were acquitted by Ld/- Trial Court on the basis of merit rather than dismissed in default of complaint. It is apt to mention here that earlier erringly both cases mentioned under the heading 'Dismissed in Default' and the mistake occurred inadvertently.</p> <p>01 case was filed by Regional Office Sonapat under Water & Air Act and in this case during the course of hearing before Ld/- Trial Court, it has been unsurfaced that one of the director expired and other one had resigned before the date of violation and on this premises complaint was withdrawn with liberty to file fresh.</p> |
