**Sanction for recruitment of Consultant for a period of six months having expertise in Environmental Science.**

It is submitted that the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 provides for 'appointment of a qualified person to be a Consultant to the Board and pay him such salary and allowances or fees as it thinks fit [(Section 14 (5) of the Act)]' (**Annexure-1**) and the same provision has been made in the rules framed by the Central Government for implementation in the CPCB as well as Pollution Control Committees which come under the jurisdiction of Union Government. However, as per the provisions in Haryana Air Prevention & Control of Pollution) Rules, 1983 it has been provided that the 'Consulting Engineer may be appointed by the Board for a specified period not exceeding four months above which the Board shall make the appointment without the prior approval of the Government'. It has also indicated that if the emoluments or fees payable to him exceeds rupees two thousand per month, prior approval of the Government is to be obtained.

The Haryana State Pollution Control Board require a person with expertise in Environmental Science (preferably with Ph. D. in Environmental Science) and with working experience in investigation on Air Quality, Environment and Health issues, Health Risk Assessment Studies with some experiences in surveys of pollutions in NCR. For the above requirement, it is not to restrict the criteria to Consulting Engineer and may consider amending its rules to change the term of 'Consulting Engineer' with 'Consultant' to accommodate wider scope in recruiting qualified professionals. Also the emoluments should also be appropriately fixed corresponding to the escalated prices and Board may be advised to consider these amendments which may be sent to the Government for consideration after Board's approval.

Additional Chief Secretary to Government Haryana, Environment & Climate Change Department, Chandigarh was requested vide this office letter no. HSPCB/Estt./2018/9226 dated 25.05.2018 (**Annexure-2**) to accord necessary permission/approval for recruitment of a Consultant with expertise in Environmental Science (preferably with Ph. D. in Environmental Science) and with working experience in investigation on Air Quality, Environment and Health issues, Health Risk Assessment Studies with some experiences in surveys of pollutions in NCR for a fixed rate of Rs. 30,000/- per month for a period of six months through walk-in-interview after giving due advertisement and publicity.

Therefore, the decision to forward the proposal for engaging the Consultant with the above qualifications to Government may be placed before the Board for its ex-post-facto approval please.

Provided that no order of removal shall be made by the State Government under this section unless the member concerned has been given a reasonable opportunity of showing cause against the same.

(3) Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-section (1) or sub-section (6) of section 7, a member who has been removed under this section shall not be eligible to continue to hold office until his successor enters upon his office, or, as the case may be, for re-nomination as a member.

**9. Vacation of seats by members.**—If a member of a State Board constituted under this Act becomes subject to any of the disqualifications specified in section 8, his seat shall become vacant.

**10. Meetings of Board.**—(1) For the purposes of this Act, a Board shall meet at least once in every three months and shall observe such rules of procedure in regard to the transaction of business at its meetings as may be prescribed:

Provided that if, in the opinion of the Chairman, any business of an urgent nature is to be transacted, he may convene a meeting of the Board at such time as he thinks fit for the aforesaid purpose.

(2) Copies of the minutes of the meetings under sub-section (1) shall be forwarded to the Central Board and to the State Government concerned.

**11. Constitution of committees.**—(1) A Board may constitute as many committees consisting wholly of members or partly of members and partly of other persons and for such purpose or purposes as it may think fit.

(2) A committee constituted under this section shall meet at such time and at such place, and shall observe such rules of procedure in regard to the transaction of business at its meetings as may be prescribed.

(3) The members of a committee other than the members of the Board shall be paid such fees and allowances, for attending its meetings and for attending to any other work of the Board as may be prescribed.

**12. Temporary association of persons with Board for particular purposes.**—(1) A Board may associate with itself in such manner, and for such purposes, as may be prescribed, any person whose assistance or advice it may desire to obtain in performing any of its functions under this Act.

(2) A person associated with the Board under sub-section (1) for any purpose shall have a right to take part in the discussions of the Board relevant to that purpose, but shall not have a right to vote at a meeting of the Board and shall not be a member of the Board for any other purpose.

(3) A person associated with a Board under sub-section (1) shall be entitled to receive such fees and allowances as may be prescribed.

**13. Vacancy in Board not to invalidate acts or proceedings.**—No act or proceeding of a Board or any committee thereof shall be called in question on the ground merely of the existence of any vacancy in, or any defect in the constitution of, the Board or such committee, as the case may be.

**14. Member-secretary and officers and other employees of State Boards.**—(1) The terms and conditions of service of the member-secretary of a State Board constituted under this Act shall be such as may be prescribed.

prescribed, or as may, from time to time, be delegated to him by the State Board or its Chairman.]

(3) Subject to such rules as may be made by the State Government in this behalf, a State Board, whether constituted under this Act or not, may appoint such officers and other employees as it considers necessary for the efficient performance of its functions under this Act.

(4) The method of appointment, the conditions of service and the scales of pay of the officers (other than the member-secretary) and other employees of a State Board appointed under sub-section (3) shall be such as may be determined by regulations made by the State Board under this Act.

(5) Subject to such conditions as may be prescribed, a State Board constituted under this Act may, from time to time, appoint any qualified person to be a consultant to the Board and pay him such salary and allowances or fees, as it thinks fit.

15. Delegation of powers.—A State Board may, by general or special order, delegate to the Chairman or the member-secretary or any other officer of the Board subject to such conditions and limitations, if any, as may be specified in the order, such of its powers and functions under this Act as it may deem necessary.

### CHAPTER III

#### POWERS AND FUNCTIONS OF BOARDS

16. Functions of Central Board.—(1) Subject to the provisions of this Act, and without prejudice to the performance of its functions under the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 (6 of 1974), the main functions of the Central Board shall be to improve the quality of air and to prevent, control or abate air pollution in the country.

(2) In particular and without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing functions, the Central Board may—

(a) advise the Central Government on any matter concerning the improvement of the quality of air and the prevention, control or abatement of air pollution;

(b) plan and cause to be executed a nation-wide programme for the prevention, control or abatement of air pollution;

(c) co-ordinate the activities of the State Boards and resolve disputes among them;

(d) provide technical assistance and guidance to the State Boards, carry out and sponsor investigations and research relating to problems of air pollution and prevention, control or abatement of air pollution;

(e) plan and organise the training of persons engaged or to be engaged in programmes for the prevention, control or abatement of air pollution on such terms and conditions as the Central Board may specify;

(f) organise through mass media a comprehensive programme regarding the prevention, control or abatement of air pollution;

**14. Member-secretary and officers and other employees of State Boards.—**

(1) The terms and conditions of service of the member-secretary of a State Board constituted under this Act shall be such as may be prescribed.

**15. #### COMMENTS

##### Act of delegation

The delegating authority, by the mere act of delegation, does not completely denude itself of its powers; *Ram Sevak Singh v. State of Bihar*, 1979 BLJR 496.

The Industries & Commerce Department, Haryana Government has notified the Enterprises Promotion Policy, 2015 vide notification No. 49/43/2015-41B1 dated 14.8.2015.

The Industries & Commerce Department, Haryana Government has further notified the constitution of the committees at State Level and District Level vide no. 49/53/2005-41B1 dated 03.2.2016 (Annexure-I) to provide single window service under one roof for time bound clearance of new project and accelerating the pace of investment in the state

As per notification dated 03.02.2016 issued by the Industries department, Haryana, HEPC has been formed and all the clearances have to be issued through HEPC as given **Annexure-I** of the notification. The registration/authorization under E-Waste rules, 2011 have to be issued through HEPC. Now the E-Waste Rules, 2011 have been superseded with E-Waste Rules, 2016. The registration is not required as per new rules and only authorization is required. The Nodal Officer of HEPC has already been empowered to grant registration/authorization under E-waste Management & Handling Rules, 2011 at Sr. No. 4 stage -I of notification No. 49/53/2005-41B1 dated 03.2.2016 for projects with investment above 10 crores or CLU cases more than 01 Acre (copy of orders is attached as **Annexure-II**). AGM, HEPC intimated to HSPCB vide PUC no. HEPC/2017/987 dated 22.05.2018 (copy attached as **Annexure III**) that services for grant of authorisation under E-Waste Rules is available with online mode on single window/HEPC portal. The powers were not delegated to Regional Officers to decide the cases in DLCC. Accordingly powers are required to be delegated to RO's under E-Waste (Management) Rules, 2016 for deciding the authorization cases up to 10, crores or CLU cases upto 01 Acre in DLCC.

In view of above, orders were issued vide Endst. No. HSPCB/2018/4160-4183 dated 01.06.2018 (**Annexure-IV**) for delegating the powers for grant/refusal of authorization to Manufacturer, Recycler, Dismantler and Refurbisher under E-Waste (Management) Rules, 2016 as specified in schedule -I of the notification issued vide no. 49/53/2005-41B1 dated 03.2.2016 (**Annexure-I**) by the Industries & Commerce Department, Haryana Government, as per following criteria:-

1. Regional Officer shall decide the authorization under E-waste (Management) Rules, 2016 for projects having investment upto 10 crores or CLU cases upto 01 Acre.
2. Regional Officer shall obtain approval of Nodal Officer, HEPC, Panchkula for projects with investment above 10 crores or CLU cases more than 01 Acre.

The matter is placed before the Board for consideration and Ex-Post Facto approval, please.

No 49/53/2005-41B1. In pursuance of the resolve of Government to provide Single Window Service under one Roof for Time Bound Clearances of new Projects and accelerating the pace of investment in the state, sanctioning special packages for Mega projects and approving any policy initiative, the Governor of Haryana is pleased to establish the Haryana Enterprise Promotion Board (HEPB). The Haryana Enterprises Promotion Board will have a Governing Council consisting of followings:

1.	Chief Minister, Haryana	Chairman
2.	Finance Minister	Member
3.	Industries Minister	Member
4.	Town and Country Planning Minister	Member
5.	Public Works Minister	Member
6.	Labour Minister	Member
7.	Environment & Forests Minister	Member
8.	Chief Secretary	Member
9.	Principal Secretary to Chief Minister	Member
10.	Principal Secretary Industries	Member-Secretary

- The HEPB may co-opt any member if so required, for proper and effective discharge of its functions.
- Under the supervision and guidance of Haryana Enterprises Promotion Board (HEPB) two tier system shall function for project clearances:
  - Empowered Executive Committee** - Projects with investment more than Rs. 10 crore and involving CLU cases of more than one acre land will be cleared by the Empowered Executive Committee of the Council under Principal Secretary to Chief Minister with administrative secretaries of Town & Country Planning, Industries & Commerce, Public Health Engineering Department, Environment, Forests, Public Works Department (Building & Roads) & Finance. The Empowered Executive Committee will exercise concurrent powers of competent authorities of 14 departments as per Annexure-1. The Empowered Executive Committee (EEC) will work under the overall supervision and guidance of HEPB headed by Chief Minister. Principal Secretary Industries will be Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of the Haryana Enterprises Promotion Board (HEPB) with Director of Industries as the Deputy Chief-Executive Officer (Dy.CEO). The Secretarial support to the HEPB and Empowered Executive Committee will be provided by the Secretariat headed by CEC of HEPB.
  - District Level Clearance Committee** - Projects with an investment upto Rs. 10 crore and Change of Land Use (CLU) cases upto one acre in conforming zones will be cleared by District Level Clearance Committee headed by Deputy Commissioner.

4. Functions of Haryana Enterprises Promotion Board (HEPB).

4.1 HEPB shall provide overall policy guidance and direction and perform the following functions, namely:-

- i. It shall be the apex body for all matters relating to the Industrial development in the state;
- ii. It shall be responsible for approving the regulations and procedures of the HEPB and allocating such functions to the Empowered Executive Committee and the CEO which are not otherwise specified;
- iii. It shall be responsible for creation, sanction, abolition and re-designation of posts required for effective functioning of the Empowered Executive Committee and District Level Clearance Committee (DLCC);
- iv. It shall regularly monitor, supervise and review the functioning of the Empowered Executive Committee (EEC) and District level Clearance Committee (DLCC);
- v. It shall approve the annual budget, accounts and reports including the audit reports of EEC

5. Empowered Executive Committee

5.1 Under the provision of Haryana Enterprises Promotion Policy Chapter 4, Para 4.11 (b) there shall be an Empowered Executive Committee to clear the projects with an investment more than Rs. 10 crore and involving CLU cases of more than one acre land and guide, monitor and review the functioning of Haryana Enterprises Promotion Centre (HEPC).

5.2 The Empowered Executive Committee shall consist of the following:

1.	Principal Secretary to CM	Chairman
2.	Additional Chief Secretary/Principal Secretary, Town & Country Planning	Member
3.	Additional Chief Secretary/Principal Secretary, PHED	Member
4.	Additional Chief Secretary/Principal Secretary, PWD (B&R)	Member
5.	Additional Chief Secretary/Principal Secretary, Finance	Member
6.	Additional Chief Secretary/Principal Secretary, Industry	Member cum CEO of EEC
7.	Additional Chief Secretary /Principal Secretary, Environment	Member
8.	Additional Chief Secretary /Principal Secretary, Forest	Member
9.	Director General Industries & Commerce	Deputy CED of the EEC

5.3 The Empowered Executive Committee may invite the concerned Administrative Secretary or any other officer of a Department as a special invitee to discuss and finalize and specific proposal or issue of such Department.

5.4 The Empowered Executive Committee may co-opt any other member, if so required, for proper and effective discharge of its functions

- 5.5 The Secretariat of Empowered Executive Committee shall function from the office of Director General Industries & Commerce having a special centre as Haryana Enterprises Promotion Centre (HEPC). Additional Chief Secretary/ Principal Secretary, Industries & Commerce will be Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of HEPC with Director General of Industries & Commerce as the Deputy CEO.
- 5.6 Functions of Empowered Executive Committee:-
- i) It shall regularly monitor, supervise and review the functioning of the HEPC;
  - ii) It shall be responsible for recommending to the Haryana Enterprises Promotion Board (HEPB) investment proposals that seek fiscal and other incentives outside the package of Fiscal Incentives for Haryana Enterprises Promotion Policy-2015. The Haryana Enterprises Promotion Board (HEPB) shall be empowered to approve any such incentives, or any relaxation or exemptions.
  - iii) It shall be responsible for organizing campaigns, events, conferences and meeting for promoting Haryana as an investment destination both in India and abroad;
  - iv) It shall carry out such other functions as may be assigned to it by the Haryana Enterprises Promotion Board (HEPB) or the State Government; and
  - v) It may refer any matter or issue to the Government or Haryana Enterprises Promotion Board (HEPB) with its recommendations or suggestions, if considered necessary.
6. Coordination Committee
- 6.1 The Empowered Executive Committee may appoint from time to time, such Coordination Committee(s) as may be considered necessary, to assist it in carrying out its functions and facilitate investments in the State.
7. Powers of Empowered Executive Committee (EEC)
- 7.1 Subject to overall control and superintendence of the Haryana Enterprises Promotion Board, the Empowered Executive Committee shall exercise the powers of 14 departments in respect of 45 services mentioned in Annexure-1. The concerned department shall delegate the concurrent powers under their respective Acts/ Rules/Orders through specific notification to the Empowered Executive Committee or the officers of the department on deputation with Haryana Enterprises Promotion Centre, (Secretariat of EEC) as an Empowered Officer to grant clearances/sanction/ NOC/certificates at par with the competent authority of the department except the approvals/sanction, currently being granted at the level of CM and for those services wherein powers are vested with the elected body/council. The power of the EEC shall also include the approvals of incentives under the provision of Haryana Enterprise Promotion Policy-2015.
- 7.2 The Empowered Executive Committee shall grant approvals within 30\* days of each stage of clearance mentioned in the Annexure-1.
- 7.3 In case any clearance is not issued within the stipulated time i.e maximum 30 days as mentioned in above para then the deemed clearance certificate may be issued by the CEO of Empowered Executive Committee about such clearance.

- 7.4 The State Government may devolve upon it any other powers, if so required, through appropriate notification.
- 7.5 These delegation of powers shall be exercised by EEC and facilitated by the Haryana Enterprises Promotion Centre (HEPC) up to the stage/date of Commencement of Production/ Operations of project. Thereafter all clearances shall be accorded by the concerned Department/ Regulatory Authority/Agency/ Boards/Corporations/Organizations.
- 7.6 EEC shall meet **must once, every fortnights** to grant sanctions/clearances to projects proposals submitted in HEPC and processed by the secretariat EEC may meet earlier also at the direction of Chairman, EEC.
8. The Haryana Enterprises Promotion Centre (HEPC) will be empowered for the following:-
- 8.1 To act as a Single Point Contact Agency to provide information, guidance and hand holding services for venture location by prospective entrepreneurs particularly with regard to various sanctions/approval needed for implementation of the projects, availability of land and present level of infrastructure in the State and to assist entrepreneurs in submission of applications for approvals/registration to different organizations. This centre will have complete data base on availability of land, water, power, finance etc. and norms, rules and regulations of all the institutions engaged in industrial development. This agency would showcase Haryana as an ultimate destination for investment.
- 8.2 The Haryana Enterprises Promotion Centre shall consist of the representatives of State Level Promotional Institutions.
- 8.3 All the powers vested with the 14 departments for statutory clearances for 45 services mentioned in annexure-1 will be transferred to the Empowered Executive Committee of the Haryana Enterprises Promotion Board (HEPB) to provide clearances at one point required for establishment and operation of industrial undertakings new and old projects.
- 8.4 A system of online clearances will be put in place by creating an e-biz Haryana portal where Composite Application form can be submitted by an investor for 45 services with most frequent industry interface for seeking/ securing online clearances/sanction/ permits/ NOCs in the HEPC.
9. Internal Regulations
- 9.1 The Empowered Executive Committee shall make and observe such procedure and regulations for Haryana Enterprises Promotion Centre as it may consider necessary and proper to transact its business to achieve the assigned task including matters concerning finance, accounts and personnel.  
Such procedure and regulations shall be notified by the State Government for information.
10. Functions of the Chief Executive Officer (CEO).
- 1) He shall receive process and approve all investment proposals including new investments, modernization, up-gradation and expansion of existing industrial units of more than Rs.10 crore or involving CLU cases of more than 1 acre after the approval from Empowered Executive Committee.

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- ii) He shall coordinate all efforts of the State Government to encourage new investment and its actualization in the State in respect of all sectors of trade, commerce and industry;
  - iii) He shall receive or cause to be received applications for new investment both from private and public agencies, and examine and process the same for all necessary statutory and other approvals;
  - iv) He shall communicate requisite approval granted by the Empowered Executive Committee subject to fulfillment of conditions specified for necessary statutory and other approvals;
  - v) He shall notify and devolve upon the applicants, whose proposals are approved by the Empowered Executive Committee, incentives as per the Package of Haryana Enterprises Promotion Policy-2015 under relevant sections of appropriate laws in keeping with the powers devolved upon it through specific notifications under such laws;
  - vi) He shall review and monitor investment in various projects in keeping with the approvals granted by it;
  - vii) He shall carry out or cause to be carried out investment audit and requisite inspections of the proposals approved by it;
  - viii) He shall resolve all inter-departmental matters and coordinate with the concerned departments qua a new investment proposal through the various officers of line departments placed with the HEPB;
  - ix) He shall prepare and submit its quarterly reports on investment promotion in the State to the HEPB for information and review and shall submit its annual report to the State Government in the Department of Industries & Commerce after it is seen and approved by the HEPB;
  - x) He shall assist a project proposal applicant for new investments in the State in such a manner as it may consider appropriate to ensure that the investment was made at the earliest possible; and
  - xi) He shall authenticate all documents on behalf of the Haryana Enterprises Promotion Centre (HEPC), in connection with due discharge of functions of the HEPC with the prior competent approvals.
11. Officers/ Employees of the HEPC
- 11.1 The HEPC will work under the overall supervision and guidance and direction of the Additional Chief Secretary/ Principal Secretary cum Chief Executive Officer of HEPB with Director of Industries as Deputy CEO.
  - 11.2 The CEO shall discharge all such functions as are assigned or may be assigned to him.
  - 11.3 The HEPB may create such other posts and appoint such other officers and employees thereon, as it may consider necessary for efficient discharge of its functions.
  - 11.4 The posts created and officers appointed by the HEPB shall amongst others, include:
    - a) Principal Secretary Industries, Department of Industries & Commerce as CEO of HEPC, Chandigarh.

- b) An officer not below the rank of Director of Industries, Department of Industries & Commerce as Deputy CEO, HEPC, Chandigarh and Delhi office
  - c) An officer not below the rank of Chief Town Planner in the Department of Town and Country Planning;
  - d) An officer not below the rank of Additional Labour Commissioner in the Department of Labour; + 01 District Labour Commissioner
  - e) An officer not below the rank of Additional Director in the Department of Urban Local Bodies, Haryana; + 01 Joint Commissioner from Municipal Corporation
  - f) An officer not below the rank of Joint Commissioner Excise & Taxation in the Department of Excise and Taxation; + 01 DETC
  - g) An officer not below the rank of Additional Director, Factories in the Department of Factories; + 01 Deputy Director
  - h) An officer not below the rank of General Manager in the Haryana State Industrial & Infrastructure Development Corporation; + 02 DGM
  - i) An officer not below the rank of Senior Town Planner in the Haryana Urban Development Authority;
  - j) An officer not below the rank of a Chief Engineer in the Haryana Pollution Control Board; + one Executive Engineer/Regional Officer, HSPCB
  - k) An officer not below the rank of Chief Conservator of Forests in the Department of Forests;
  - l) An officer not below the rank of General Manager in DOSCO, Uttar/Dakshin Haryana Bijli Vitran Nigam Ltd.; + 01 DGM
  - m) An officer not below the rank of Joint Controller, Finance & Accounts in the Department of Finance;
  - n) An Officer not below the rank of District Revenue officer.
  - o) An officer not below the rank of Additional Director in Department of Industries & Commerce, Haryana for Chandigarh and Delhi office - 02 Joint Director(s) of Industries.
- 11.5 The services of the officers noted above shall be placed with the HEPC on deputation by the concerned administrative departments/organizations. In case an officer from the above mentioned list is not placed on deputation by concerned department/organization, the Empowered Executive Committee shall be authorized to delegate the powers with respect to that particular officer/department/organization to any other officer of the HEPC. In case the department/organization is unable to provide the officer of the rank mentioned above, the deputed officer shall be deemed to be in the rank mentioned above till he remains on deputation with HEPC. However, this will not entitle him any additional financial benefit on this account.
- 11.6 The conditions of service of officers and other employees as appointed in the HEPC and their functions and duties shall be such as may be specified by the HEPC. However, the officers as mentioned in para 11.4 above whose services are placed with the HEPC on deputation shall continue to be governed under

the relevant rules and regulations of their respective cadres in their parent departments/organizations.

- 11.7 As far as possible, the officers and employees of the HEPC other than those mentioned in para 11.4, shall also be taken on deputation recruited on contractual basis on such terms and conditions as approved by the Empowered Executive Committee of HEPC. The detail of the same is annexed as annexure-2.
- 11.8 The CEO of the HEPC shall exercise the powers of supervision and control over all the officers and employees of the HEPC. He shall sign all the contracts of the employees after due sanction of the competent authority. He shall also be the competent authority to sign all documents, approvals and sanctions granted or issued by the HEPC.
12. Meetings
  - 12.1 The HEPB shall meet as often as required to carry out its functions but it shall meet at least once in six months.
  - 12.2 Likewise, the Empowered Executive Committee of the Board shall meet as often as may be required to carry out the task assigned to it but it shall meet at least once in two months.
  - 12.3 The members of the HEPB and the Empowered Executive Committee shall be entitled for reimbursement of traveling expenses and daily allowance as may be decided by the HEPB but not less than the entitlement of its CEO.
13. Financing of the HEPC
  - 13.1 The HEPC shall be funded by the State Government in the Department of Industries & Commerce, Haryana by way of Grant in Aid.
  - 13.2 The HEPC may receive such fee or charges on the proposals processed by it as may be specified.
  - 13.3 The HEPC may maintain a separate bank account of its receipts and expenditure which shall be audited annually by the statutory and government auditors.
  - 13.4 The HEPC shall finalize its quarterly and annual receipts and expenditure accounts within 30 days from the close of the relevant quarter/year.
  - 13.5 The delegation of financial powers shall be as under:
    - a) Haryana Enterprises Promotion Board level - full powers
    - b) Empowered Executive Committee level - Upto Rs 1 crore
    - c) Chief Executive Officer level - Upto Rs 10 lacs
14. Powers to Remove Difficulties
  - 14.1 If any difficulty arises in proper discharge of its functions, the Chief Executive Officer shall make a reference to the Empowered Executive Committee with its suggestions/ proposals to remove such difficulties and the decision of the Empowered Executive Committee in this regard shall be binding, subject to ratification by the Haryana Enterprises Promotion Board.
15. Powers to issue Directions
  - 15.1 The State Government in the Department of Industries & Commerce, Haryana shall, if so required, have the powers to issue policy directions to the HEPC on matters assigned to it and all such directions shall be binding on the HEPC.

16. Powers to Delegate

16.1 The HEPB may delegate any of its powers to the Empowered Executive Committee or the Chief Executive Officer as the case may be through a specific resolution in connection therewith.

17 District Level Clearance Committee (DLCC):

17.1 As per the provision of 4.11(C) Enterprises Promotion Policy- 2015, Projects with an investment upto Rs.10 crore or CLU cases upto 1 acre in conforming zones will be cleared by District Level Clearance Committee headed by Deputy Commissioner for the respective district under the supervision and guidance of Haryana Enterprises Promotion Board. The DLCC shall consist of the followings:

17.2 Nodal agency:- The office of Joint Director/Deputy Director of District shall Act as Nodal agency of the District level clearance committee of the concerned District.

17.3 The District Level Clearance Committee shall consider the applications for clearances submitted by an investor for 45 services mentioned in Annexure 1 of the notification.

18 Composite Application form (CAF), processing and monitoring of CAF

1. Every applicant seeking to apply for clearances required for establishment or operation of an Industry mentioned in Annexure 1 of notification shall apply through online portal of Department of Industries. The CAF of the project upto the investment of Rs. 10 crore or CLU cases upto 1 acre in conforming zone will be sent online to the Nodal agency of the concerned District and the relevant part of the same shall be sent by Nodal agency to the concerned authority/



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- office for necessary clearance/approval/ report on the same day or on second day after its receipt.
2. The authority shall process the application and send its orders sanctioning or rejecting the application, as the case may be, to the nodal agency so that the same can be given to the applicant.
  3. The authority may ask for additional information from the applicant within 7 days only through the nodal agency and with its approval.
  4. The concerned department shall delegate the concurrent powers under their respective Acts/ Rules/Orders through specific notification to the officers of the department posted at the district headquarter as an Empowered Officer to grant clearances/sanction/NOC/certificates at par with the competent authority of the department except the approvals/sanction, currently being granted at the level of CM and for those services wherein, powers are vested with the elected body/council.
  5. The time limit shall be applicable from the date of the additional information has been furnished by the applicant for approval of clearance by the concerned authority.
  6. In case the application is rejected or approved with modifications by the authority than DLCC shall examine such orders passed by the authority and if the committee considers that there are valid grounds for a change in such decisions, it shall take a decision which shall be binding on the authority as per 11(1) of the Haryana Industrial Promotion Act, 2005.
  7. The deemed clearance certificate shall be issued by the Member-Secretary of District Level Clearance Committee on the approval of DLCC in such cases wherein the clearances are not issued within the prescribed period as per 11.1 of Haryana Industrial Promotion Act, 2005.
  8. In case the clearance of the particular services is not provided within time limit as prescribed in the annexure-1 annexed with the notification i.e. time prescribed 30 days for all three stages of the 45 services then the applicant may opt to file complaint against the authority of the concerned department under Right to Service Act, 2015 by which the clearance was to be issued. The State Govt. has already notified 119 such services under the Right to Service Act, 2015.
- 19 Meeting of District Level Clearance Committee.
1. The District Level Clearance Committee shall meet at least once in a week at district headquarters or at such other place as the Chairman may specify from time-to time to transact its business and it can meet more than 1 time if the work load requires so.
  2. Details of all the Composite Application Forms received from entrepreneurs prior to the ensuing meeting shall be placed before the DLCC.
  3. The Member Secretary shall by issuing a meeting notice, convene a meeting of district level Clearance Committee indicating the date, time and place of the

meeting. He shall enclose agenda and notes highlighting therein details of the applications cleared, application cleared with modifications, rejected, information regarding the date on which application deemed to have been approved in the case of deemed approvals and other observations, if any received from the authority for the transaction of business in the said meeting.

4. Member-Secretary shall also communicate the date, time place of the meeting to the entrepreneurs, whose cases are included in the agenda.
  5. All the members and invitees of the District Level Clearance Committee shall attend the meeting in person and shall not depute their representatives.
  6. The District Level Clearance Committee shall examine all the proposals placed before it and take appropriate decisions.
  7. The Member - Secretary of the Committee shall within three days circulate the proceedings of the meeting after taking approval of the Chairman.
  8. Within two days of circulation of the proceedings of the meeting, the Member-Secretary shall communicate the decision of the Committee to the authorities and the entrepreneur concerned.
  9. The authority shall grant or issue the necessary clearances within three days of the Committee.
- 20 Deemed Clearance.
1. In case of applications pending with authorities concerned beyond the time limit, the committee shall examine all such applications and pass orders for issuance of deemed clearance which shall be binding on the authorities as per 11(1) of Haryana Industrial Promotion Act, 2005.
  2. As per the provision of Chapter 4 of para 4.1.2 of Haryana Enterprises Promotion Policy-2015 all the clearances shall be delivered within 30 days for all 3 stages mentioned in the annexure-1 appended to the notification except wherein the clearances are required from Government of India.
  3. The certificate of deemed clearance shall be issued by the nodal agency of DLCC in the certificate of deemed clearance annexed as Annexure 'A'





The applicant desirous for Recycling, Dismantling and Refurbishing of E-Waste shall submit the application on HEPC portal regarding grant / renewal of authorization for Recycling / Dismantling / Refurbishing of E-Waste on Form 1(a) / Form 4. The Recycler / Dismantler / Refurbisher will apply for the authorization / renewal of authorization along with copy of the consent to establish, copy of certificate of registration from DIC, proof of installed capacity issued by the DIC or any other authorized Govt. agency, along with other documents as mentioned in the check list given at Annexure-A. The manufacture generating E-Waste shall submit an application of authorization on form 1(a), with the details of appropriate facilities, technical capabilities and equipments to handle the E-Waste on single window / HEPC portal only. No application under E-Waste (Management) Rules, 2016 will be accepted in HSPCB on hard copy.

After the receipt of complete case on HEPC portal from Recycler/ Dismantler/Refurbisher of E-Waste, inspection shall be carried out by a team of officers of the Board consisting of Regional Officer and Concerned field officer alongwith one AEE/Scientist -B of adjoining Region to verify whether the applicant has installed the e-waste processing facility with Environmentally sound technologies and possessed adequate technical capabilities, requisite facilities and equipment for dismantling / recycling / refurbishing of E-Waste, and required pollution control measures as per provision of the Rules and Guidelines issued there under by CPCB. The Regional Officer will prepare the detailed report on the prescribed format given at Annexure-B

The power to decide cases of authorization for grant / refusal shall be as per following criteria -

1. Regional Officer shall decide the authorization under E-waste (Management) Rules, 2016 for projects having investment upto 10 crores or CLU cases upto 01 Acre.
2. Regional Officer shall obtain approval of Nodal Officer, HEPC, Panchkula for projects with investment above 10 crores or CLU cases more than 01 Acre.

The authorization shall be issued on the pass book as prescribed by HSPCB, in case it is refused, the procedure will be adopted on ment of the case. The Authorization issued to the recycler / dismantler / manufacturer will carry the validity of 05 years and refurbisher need to take only one time authorization from the Board.

The status of all such authorization granted by the Board will be displayed on the website of the Board under the heading "Authorized Dismantler/Recycler/Refurbisher in State of Haryana under E-Waste (Management) Rules, 2016".

All the concerned shall ensure the compliance of the above said decision of the Board effectively.

As per the existing provisions at Item No. III of schedule-II of notification dated 11.05.2016 issued by the Government of Haryana, Environment Department, all the stone crushing units which do not meet the siting criteria prescribed in this notification shall have to shift to the site meeting the siting parameters as per schedule-I of this notification or to identified zone depending on availability of vacant sites in the zone, within 3 years from the date of issuance of this notification which is extendable for another one year provided that stone crushing unit procures the land for a site meeting the siting norms as per this notification, before the expiry of 3 years and applies to Haryana State Pollution Control Board.

A representation was received from stone crusher owners of Khanak, District - Bhiwani through the O/o Additional Chief Secretary, Environment Department (copy enclosed as **Annexure-A**) in which they have requested for amendment in certain parameters of schedule -I of notification 11.05.2016. In their representation, the stone crusher owners have intimated that they are running their stone crushers for the last 25 to 30 years with all the permission from the respective Departments and also have installed APCM prescribed as per notification and taking consent every year. Further they have intimated that Environment Department has changed some siting parameters in the new notification dated 11.05.2016 and have not given any relief to the existing units as earlier they were given relief under clause II-N of notification 18.12.1997. They requested to continue the relief given to them as given under clause II-N of notification dated 18.12.1997. In their representation they have intimated that the area where they have installed the stone crushers is not a fertile land and level of ground water is very low, the land cannot be utilized for any other purpose and the existing units are the only source of livelihood to them as well as inhabitants of the area. The representation submitted by association was forwarded to the Regional Officer, Jind at Bhiwani vide letter dated 01.03.2018 (copy

enclosed as **Annexure-B**) for giving his recommendation after verification of facts.

The Regional Officer, Jind at Bhiwani has submitted his recommendation vide letter dated 31.05.2018 (copy enclosed as **Annexure -C**) in which he has intimated that he has also received a representation from Stone Crusher Owners, Khanak vide letter dated 22.05.2018 for extension of already existing Khanak stone crusher zone in District Bhiwani. Regional Officer has intimated that at present there are approx 253 stone crushing units established in Khanak area. Several number of these units are not meeting sitting permeates as per notification dated 11.05.2016. There are approximately 49 no. of Stone Crushing units which were established before first notification of Environment Department in 1992. Now as per new notification of Environment Department dated 11.05.2016, all those units who are not meeting sitting parameter as per item no. III of schedule -II has to shift to the new location which is meeting sitting parameters. The Regional Officer, Jind at Bhiwani has intimated that while inspecting the said area, it is observed that the prominent activity in this area is stone crushing because large quantity of raw material in the form of stone mines is available nearby and large number of stone crushing units and their allied units are also working in this area. Stone crushing and mining activity are the main source of livelihood as well as providing of employment to the inhabitants .

The Regional Officer has recommended that the representation of the Stone Crusher Owners, Khanak can be considered and Khanak Stone Crusher Zone can be extended on both sides of the existing notified Khanak Zone as per the detail of land attached with his letter dated 31.05.2018. Further Regional Officer has recommended for forwarding the case for extension of already existing Kanak Zone to the Environment Department, Govt. of Haryana for consideration as per the request of stone crusher owners, Khanak.

The matter is placed before the Board for consideration and approval please.

1. Serial No. 2- Criteria for minimum distance required from any road.

**Sub:** Representation received from stone crusher Owners, Khanak, Distt. Bhiwani regarding relaxation/amendment in the siting parameters of notification dated 11.05.2016 issued by Environment Department, Govt. of Haryana.

**Ref:** H.O letter no. 3440 dated 01.03.2018 and request letter of Khanak Stone Crusher Owners Welfare Society vide letter dated 22.05.2018.

In this connection, it is intimated that request is received from representative of the Khanak Stone Crusher units regarding extension of notified existing Khanak Stone Crushers Zone. In their presentation they have mentioned that at present there are approx 253 stone crushing units established in Khanak area. Several number of these units are not meeting siting parameters as per notification dated, 11.05.2016. They have requested for extension of existing Khanak Zone because several of these units have been established before 1992 and they are running their units from last 30 to 35 years in this area and had start APCM on their units prescribed by HSPCB as per notification 18.12.1997 and also take consent from HSPCB every year. They have also stated that land in this area not fertile and ground water level is also low. So there is less possibility for Agriculture or any other activity except stone crushing units.

After inspecting the said area along with revenue department representative and study of their presentation it has been observed that first notification of Environment department in regard to stone crushing units was issued in 1992 and few crushers units were established in Khanak before the above referred notification. Again a notification dated 18.12.1997 was issued covering all aspects and those crushers units which were established before the said notification and not meeting siting parameter were given benefit.

There are approx 49 no. of stone crushing units which were established before first notification of Environment department in 1992. Now as per new notification of Environment department dated 11.05.2016 all those units who are not meeting siting parameter in any form as per item no. III has to shift to the new location which is meeting the siting parameter as per schedule I of said notification. The detail of these 49 numbers of Crushing units is attached as Annexure-A.

The detail of crushing units installed in Khanak area is shown on rough Sizra plan along with existing crushing zone and new zone to be extended is also marked. The copy of rough Akash Sizra plan of Khanak area showing the location of all the stone crushers and stone crusher which are not meeting norms are marked in different color on the plan attached as Annexure-B obtained from the Revenue department.

While inspecting the said area it is observed that the prominent activity in this area is stone crushing because large amount of raw material in the form of stone mines is available nearby and large number of stone crushing units and their allied units also working in this area. Therefore stone crushing and mining activity are main source of livelihood as well as provider of employment to the habitants of this and nearby locality.

In view of above mentioned facts their representation can be consider and it is proposed that Khanak Zone extension can be done on both side of the existing notified Khanak zone. The total area of the purposed zone extension is 1566 acre, 2 Kanal, 16 Marla out of which 530 acre, 5 Kanal, 2 Marla has already been occupied either by stone crushing units or other structures and about 1035 acre, 5 Kanal, 14 Marla is lying vacant for establishment of new stone crusher units. This area can be utilize for extension for already notified Khanak zone. The land detail for extension of Khanak zone attached as Annexure-C. The case for extension of existing zone Khanak may be forward to the Government for consideration if approved please.

**Procedure for grant/refusal of registration cases under, Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016.**

The Industries & Commerce Department, Haryana Government has notified the Enterprises Promotion Policy, 2015 vide notification No. 49/43/2015-41B1 dated 14.8.2015.

The Industries & Commerce Department, Haryana Government has further notified the constitution of the committees at State Level and District Level vide no. 49/53/2005-41B1 dated 03.2.2016 (Annexure-I) to provide single window service under one roof for time bound clearance of new project and accelerating the pace of investment in the state

As per notification dated 03.02.2016 issued by the Industries department, Haryana, HEPC has been formed and all the clearances have to be issued through HEPC as given **Annexure-I** of the notification. The registration under Plastic Waste (Management and Handling) Rules, 2011 have to be issued through HEPC. Now the Plastic Waste (Management and Handling) Rules, 2011 have been superseded with Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016. The Nodal Officer of HEPC has already been empowered to grant registration/authorization under Plastic Waste (Management and Handling) Rules, 2011 at Sr. No. 4 stage -I of notification No. 49/53/2005-41B1 dated 03.2.2016 for projects with investment above 10 crores or CLU cases more than 01 Acre (copy of orders is attached as **Annexure-II**).

The applicant desirous for obtaining registration as producer and brand owners, recyclers and processors, manufacturers under Plastic Waste (Management) Rules, 2016 shall submit the application on HEPC portal regarding grant/renewal of registration as producer and brand owners, recyclers and processors, manufacturers on Form I/Form II/Form III. The producer and brand owners will submit application on Form I alongwith the list of the documents attached as **Annexure-'A'**. The recycler / processors will have to submit the application for registration on Form-II alongwith the list of the documents attached as **Annexure-'B'**. The manufacturer will have to submit the application for registration alongwith the list of the documents attached as **Annexure-'C'**.

After the receipt of complete case on HEPC portal from producer and brand owners, recyclers and processors, manufacturers under Plastic Waste (Management) Rules, 2016, the State Pollution Control Board, after such enquiry as it considers necessary and on being satisfied that the applicant posses appropriate facilities, technical capabilities and equipment to handle Plastic Waste safely, may grant registration to the applicant on fulfillment of the conditions as may be laid down in terms of registration. The inspection shall be carried out by the Officer of Board for verifying the submissions of unit and compliance of PWM Rules, 2016 as per format at **Annexure-'D'**.

State Pollution Control Board shall take a decision on the grant of registration within stipulated time period as prescribed by HEPC. The registration granted under this rule shall initially be valid for a period of 01 year, unless revoked, suspended or cancelled and shall subsequently be granted for 03 years. Every application for renewal

of registration shall be made atleast 120 days before the expiry of validity of registration certificate.

The services for grant of registration under Plastic Waste Management Rules are available with online mode on single window/HEPC portal. The powers were not delegated to RO's to decide the cases in DLCC. Accordingly powers are required to be delegated to the Regional Officers under Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016 for deciding the registration cases up to 10 crores or CLU cases upto 01 Acre in DLCC.

In view of above, orders were issued vide Endst. No. HSPCB/2018/4208-4231 dated 05.06.2018 (**Annexure-'III'**) for delegating the powers for grant/refusal of registration to producer and brand owners, recyclers and processors, manufacturers under Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016 as specified in schedule -I of the notification issued vide no. 49/53/2005-41B1 dated 03.2.2016 (Annexure-I) by the Industries & Commerce Department, Haryana Government, may be delegated as per following criteria:-

1. Regional Officer shall decide the registration under Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016 for projects having investment upto 10 crores or CLU cases upto 01 Acre.
2. Regional Officer shall obtain approval of Nodal Officer, HEPC, Panchkula for projects with investment above 10 crores or CLU cases more than 01 Acre.

The matter is placed before the Board for consideration and Ex-Post Facto approval, please.

THE HARYANA ENTERPRISES Promotion Board will have a Governing Council consisting of following:

2. The HEPB may co-opt any member if so required, for proper and effective discharged of its functions.
3. Under the supervision and guidance of Haryana Enterprises Promotion Board (HEPB) two tier system shall function for project clearances:
  - i. Empowered Executive Committee - Projects with investment more than Rs.10 crore and involving CLU cases of more than one acre land will be cleared by the Empowered Executive Committee of the Council under Principal Secretary to Chief Minister with administrative secretaries of Town & Country Planning, Industries & Commerce, Public Health Engineering Department, Environment, Forests, Public Works Department (Building & Roads) & Finance. The Empowered Executive Committee will exercise concurrent powers of competent authorities of 14 departments as per Annexure-1. The Empowered Executive Committee (EEC) will work under the overall supervision and guidance of HEPB headed by Chief Minister. Principal Secretary Industries will be Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of the Haryana Enterprises Promotion Board (HEPB) with Director of Industries as the Deputy Chief Executive Officer (Dy.CEO). The Secretarial support to the HEPB and Empowered Executive Committee will be provided by the Secretariat headed by CEO of HEPB.
  - ii. District Level Clearance Committee - Projects with an investment upto Rs.10 crore and Change of Land Use (CLU) cases...

## 4. Functions of Haryana Enterprises Promotion Board (HEPB).

4.1 HEPB shall provide overall policy guidance and direction and perform the following functions, namely:-

- i. It shall be the apex body for all matters relating to the industrial development in the state;
- ii. It shall be responsible for approving the regulations and procedures of the HEPB and allocating such functions to the Empowered Executive Committee and the CEO which are not otherwise specified;
- iii. It shall be responsible for creation, sanction, abolition and re-designation of posts required for effective functioning of the Empowered Executive Committee and District Level Clearance Committee (DLCC);
- iv. It shall regularly monitor, supervise and review the functioning of the Empowered Executive Committee (EEC) and District level Clearance Committee (DLCC);
- v. It shall approve the annual budget, accounts and reports including the audit reports of EEC

## 5. Empowered Executive Committee

5.1 Under the provision of Haryana Enterprises Promotion Policy Chapter 4, Para 4.11 (b) there shall be an Empowered Executive Committee to clear the projects with an investment more than Rs. 10 crore and involving CLU cases of more than one acre land and guide, monitor and review the functioning of Haryana Enterprises Promotion Centre (HEPC).

5.2 The Empowered Executive Committee shall consist of the following:

5.3 The Empowered Executive Committee may invite the concerned Administrative Secretary or any other officer of a Department as a special invitee to discuss and finalize and specific proposal or issue of such Department.

5.4 The Empowered Executive Committee may co-opt any other member, if so required, for proper and effective discharge of its functions.



5.5 The Secretariat of Empowered Executive Committee shall function from the office of Director General Industries & Commerce having a special centre as Haryana Enterprises Promotion Centre (HEPC). Additional Chief Secretary/ Principal Secretary, Industries & Commerce will be Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of HEPC with Director General of Industries & Commerce as the Deputy (CEO).

5.6 Functions of Empowered Executive Committee:-

- i) It shall regularly monitor, supervise and review the functioning of the HEPC;
- ii) It shall be responsible for recommending to the Haryana Enterprises Promotion Board (HEPB) investment proposals that seek fiscal and other incentives outside the package of Fiscal Incentives for Haryana Enterprises Promotion Policy-2015. The Haryana Enterprises Promotion Board (HEPB) shall be empowered to approve any such incentives, or any relaxation or exemptions.
- iii) It shall be responsible for organizing campaigns, events, conferences and meeting for promoting Haryana as an investment destination both in India and abroad;
- iv) It shall carry out such other functions as may be assigned to it by the Haryana Enterprises Promotion Board (HEPB) or the State Government; and
- v) It may refer any matter or issue to the Government or Haryana Enterprises Promotion Board (HEPB) with its recommendations or suggestions, if considered necessary.

6. Coordination Committee

6.1 The Empowered Executive Committee may appoint from time to time, such Coordination Committee(s) as may be considered necessary, to assist it in carrying out its functions and facilitate investments in the State.

7. Powers of Empowered Executive Committee (EEC)

7.1 Subject to overall control and superintendence of the Haryana Enterprises Promotion Board, the Empowered Executive Committee shall exercise the powers of 14 departments in respect of 45 services mentioned in Annexure-1. The concerned department shall delegate the concurrent powers under their respective Acts/ Rules/Orders through specific notification to the Empowered Executive Committee or the officers of the department on deputation with Haryana Enterprises Promotion Centre, (Secretariat of EEC) as an Empowered Officer to grant clearances/sanction/ NOC/certificates at par with the competent authority of the department except the approvals/sanction, currently being granted at the level of CM and for those services wherein, powers are vested with the elected body/council. The power of the EEC shall also include the approvals of incentives under the provision of Haryana Enterprise Promotion Policy-2015.

7.2 The Empowered Executive Committee shall grant approvals within 30 days of each stage of clearance mentioned in the Annexure-1.

7.3 In case any clearance is not issued within the stipulated time i.e maximum 30 days as mentioned in above para then the deemed clearance certificate may be issued by the CEO of Empowered Executive Committee about such clearance.

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7.4 The State Government may devolve upon it any other powers, if so required, through appropriate notification.

7.5 These delegation of powers shall be exercised by EEC and facilitated by the Haryana Enterprises Promotion Centre (HEPC) up to the stage/date of Commencement of Production/ Operations of project. Thereafter all clearances shall be accorded by the concerned Department/ Regulatory Authority/Agency/ Boards/Corporations/Organizations.

7.6 EEC shall meet must once, every fortnights to grant sanctions/clearances to projects proposals submitted in HEPC and processed by the secretariat EEC may meet earlier also at the direction of Chairman, EEC.

8. The Haryana Enterprises Promotion Centre (HEPC) will be empowered for the following:-

8.1 To act as a Single Point Contact Agency to provide information, guidance and hand holding services for venture location by prospective entrepreneurs particularly with regard to various sanctions/approval needed for implementation of the projects, availability of land and present level of infrastructure in the State and to assist entrepreneurs in submission of applications for approvals/registration to different organizations. This centre will have complete data base on availability of land, water, power, finance etc. and norms, rules and regulations of all the institutions engaged in industrial development. This agency would showcase Haryana as an ultimate destination for investment.

8.2 The Haryana Enterprises Promotion Centre shall consist of the representatives of State Level Promotional Institutions.

8.3 All the powers vested with the 14 departments for statutory clearances for 45 services mentioned in annexure-1 will be transferred to the Empowered Executive Committee of the Haryana Enterprises Promotion Board (HEPB) to provide clearances at one point required for establishment and operation of industrial undertakings new and old projects.

8.4 A system of online clearances will be put in place by creating an e-biz Haryana portal where Composite Application form can be submitted by an investor for 45 services with most frequent industry interface for seeking/ securing online clearances/sanction/ permits/ NOCs in the HEPC.

9. Internal Regulations

9.1 The Empowered Executive Committee shall make and observe such procedure and regulations for Haryana Enterprises Promotion Centre as it may consider necessary and proper to transact its business to achieve the assigned task including matters concerning finance, accounts and personnel.

Such procedure and regulations shall be notified by the State Government for information.

10. Functions of the Chief Executive Officer (CEO).

- i) He shall receive process and approve all investment proposals including new investments, modernization, up-gradation and expansion of existing industrial units of more than Rs.10 crore or involving CLU cases of more than 1 acre after the approval from Empowered Executive Committee.

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- ii) He shall coordinate all efforts of the State Government to encourage new investment and its actualization in the State in favour of all sectors of trade, commerce and industry;
  - iii) He shall receive or cause to be received applications for new investment both from private and public agencies, and examine and process the same for all necessary statutory and other approvals;
  - iv) He shall communicate requisite approval granted by the Empowered Executive Committee Subject to fulfillment of conditions specified for necessary statutory and other approvals;
  - v) He shall notify and devolve upon the applicants, whose proposals are approved by the Empowered Executive Committee, incentives as per the Package of Haryana Enterprises Promotion Policy-2015 under relevant sections of appropriate laws in keeping with the powers devolved upon it through specific notifications under such laws;
  - vi) He shall review and monitor investment in various projects in keeping with the approvals granted by it;
  - vii) He shall carry out or cause to be carried out investment audit and requisite inspections of the proposals approved by it;
  - viii) He shall resolve all inter-departmental matters and coordinate with the concerned departments qua a new investment proposal through the various officers of line departments placed with the HEPB;
  - ix) He shall prepare and submit its quarterly reports on investment promotion in the State to the HEPB for information and review and shall submit its annual report to the State Government in the Department of Industries & Commerce after it is seen and approved by the HEPB;
  - x) He shall assist a project proposal applicant for new investments in the State in such a manner as it may consider appropriate to ensure that the investment was made at the earliest possible; and
  - xi) He shall authenticate all documents on behalf of the Haryana Enterprises Promotion Centre (HEPC), in connection with due discharge of functions of the HEPC with the prior competent approvals.
11. Officers/ Employees of the HEPC
- 11.1 The HEPC will work under the overall supervision and guidance and direction of the Additional Chief Secretary/ Principal Secretary cum Chief Executive Officer of HEPB with Director of Industries as Deputy CEO.
  - 11.2 The CEO shall discharge all such functions as are assigned or may be assigned to him.
  - 11.3 The HEPB may create such other posts and appoint such other officers and employees thereon, as it may consider necessary for efficient discharge of its functions.
  - 11.4 The posts created and officers appointed by the HEPB shall amongst others, include:
    - a) Principal Secretary Industries, Department of Industries & Commerce as CEO of HEPC, Chandigarh.

the relevant rules and regulations of their respective cadres in their parent departments/organizations.

- 11.7 As far as possible, the officers and employees of the HEPC other than those mentioned in para 11.4, shall also be taken on deputation recruited on contractual basis on such terms and conditions as approved by the Empowered Executive Committee of HEPC. The detail of the same is annexed as annexure-2.
- 11.8 The CEO of the HEPC shall exercise the powers of supervision and control over all the officers and employees of the HEPC. He shall sign all the contracts of the employees after due sanction of the competent authority. He shall also be the competent authority to sign all documents, approvals and sanctions granted or issued by the HEPC.
12. Meetings
- 12.1 The HEPB shall meet as often as required to carry out its functions but it shall meet at least once in six months.
- 12.2 Likewise, the Empowered Executive Committee of the Board shall meet as often as may be required to carry out the task assigned to it but it shall meet at least once in two months.
- 12.3 The members of the HEPB and the Empowered Executive Committee shall be entitled for reimbursement of traveling expenses and daily allowance as may be decided by the HEPB but not less than the entitlement of its CEO.
13. Financing of the HEPC
- 13.1 The HEPC shall be funded by the State Government in the Department of Industries & Commerce, Haryana by way of Grant in Aid.
- 13.2 The HEPC may receive such fee or charges on the proposals processed by it as may be specified.
- 13.3 The HEPC may maintain a separate bank account of its receipts and expenditure which shall be audited annually by the statutory and government auditors.
- 13.4 The HEPC shall finalize its quarterly and annual receipts and expenditure accounts within 30 days from the close of the relevant quarter/year.
- 13.5 The delegation of financial powers shall be as under:
- a) Haryana Enterprises Promotion Board level - full powers
  - b) Empowered Executive Committee level - Upto Rs 1 crore
  - c) Chief Executive Officer level - Upto Rs 10 lacs
14. Powers to Remove Difficulties
- 14.1 If any difficulty arises in proper discharge of its functions, the Chief Executive Officer shall make a reference to the Empowered Executive Committee with its suggestions/ proposals to remove such difficulties and the decision of the Empowered Executive Committee in this regard shall be binding, subject to ratification by the Haryana Enterprises Promotion Board.
15. Powers to issue Directions
- 15.1 The State Government in the Department of Industries & Commerce, Haryana shall, if so required, have the powers to issue policy directions to the HEPC on matters assigned to it and all such directions shall be binding on the HEPC.

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16. **Powers to Delegate**

16.1 The HEPB may delegate any of its powers to the Empowered Executive Committee or the Chief Executive Officer as the case may be through a specific resolution in connection therewith.

17 **District Level Clearance Committee (DLCC):**

17.1 As per the provision of 4.11(C) Enterprises Promotion Policy- 2015, Projects with an investment upto Rs.10 crore or CLU cases upto 1 acre in conforming zones will be cleared by District Level Clearance Committee headed by Deputy Commissioner for the respective district under the supervision and guidance of Haryana Enterprises Promotion Board. The DLCC shall consist of the followings:

17.2 Nodal agency:- The office of Joint Director/Deputy Director of District shall Act as Nodal agency of the District level clearance committee of the concerned District.

17.3 The District Level Clearance Committee shall consider the applications for clearances submitted by an investor for 45 services mentioned in Annexure 1 of the notification.

18 **Composite Application form (CAF), processing and monitoring of CAF**

1. Every applicant seeking to apply for clearances required for establishment or operation of an Industry mentioned in Annexure 1 of notification shall apply through online portal of Department of Industries. The CAF of the project upto the investment of Rs. 10 crore or CLU cases upto 1 acre in conforming zone will be sent online to the Nodal agency of the concerned District and the relevant part of the same shall be sent by Nodal agency to the concerned authority.

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office for necessary clearance/approval/ report on the same day or on second day after its receipt.

2. The authority shall process the application and send its orders sanctioning or rejecting the application, as the case may be, to the nodal agency so that the same can be given to the applicant.
3. The authority may ask for additional information from the applicant within 7 days only through the nodal agency and with its approval.
4. The concerned department shall delegate the concurrent powers under their respective Acts/ Rules/Orders through specific notification to the officers of the department posted at the district headquarter as an Empowered Officer to grant clearances/sanction/NOC/certificates at par with the competent authority of the department except the approvals/sanction, currently being granted at the level of CM and for those services wherein, powers are vested with the elected body/council.
5. The time limit shall be applicable from the date of the additional information has been furnished by the applicant for approval of clearance by the concerned authority.
6. In case the application is rejected or approved with modifications by the authority than DLCC shall examine such orders passed by the authority and if the committee considers that there are valid grounds for a change in such decisions, it shall take a decision which shall be binding on the authority as per 11(1) of the Haryana Industrial Promotion Act, 2005.
7. The deemed clearance certificate shall be issued by the Member-Secretary of District Level Clearance Committee on the approval of DLCC in such cases wherein the clearances are not issued within the prescribed period as per 11.1 of Haryana Industrial Promotion Act, 2005.
8. In case the clearance of the particular services is not provided within time limit as prescribed in the annexure-1 annexed with the notification i.e. time prescribed 30 days for all three stages of the 45 services then the applicant may opt to file complaint against the authority of the concerned department under Right to Service Act, 2015 by which the clearance was to be issued. The State Govt. has already notified 119 such services under the Right to Service Act, 2015.

#### 19 Meeting of District Level Clearance Committee.

1. The District Level Clearance Committee shall meet at least once in a week at district headquarters or at such other place as the Chairman may specify from time to time to transact its business and it can meet more than 1 time if the work load requires so.
2. Details of all the Composite Application Forms received from entrepreneurs prior to the ensuing meeting shall be placed before the DLCC.
3. The Member Secretary shall by issuing a meeting notice, convene a meeting of district Level Clearance Committee indicating the date, time and place of the



The Ministry of Environment and Forests, Govt. of India vide notification no. GSR 320 E dated 18.03.2016 has issued the Plastic Waste (Management) Rules, 2016 applicable w.e.f. 18.03.2016 and authorized the State Pollution Control Board for grant of registration as producer and brand owners, recyclers and processors, manufacturers under Plastic Waste (Management) Rules, 2016.

The industry department Govt. of Haryana has issued notification vide no. 49/53/2005 - 41B1 dt:- 03.02.2016 for issuance of various clearances through HEPC single window. The applicant desirous for obtaining registration as producer and brand owners, recyclers and processors, manufacturers under Plastic Waste (Management) Rules, 2016 shall submit the application on HEPC portal regarding grant / renewal of registration as producer and brand owners, recyclers and processors, manufacturers on Form I/Form II/Form III. The producer and brand owners will submit application on Form I alongwith the list of the documents attached as Annexure-'A'. The recycler / processors will have to submit the application for registration on Form-II alongwith the list of the documents attached as Annexure-'B'. The manufacturer will have to submit the application for registration alongwith the list of the documents attached as Annexure-'C'.

After the receipt of complete case on HEPC portal from producer and brand owners, recyclers and processors, manufacturers under Plastic Waste (Management) Rules, 2016, the State Pollution Control Board, after such enquiry as it considers necessary and on being satisfied that the applicant possesses appropriate facilities, technical capabilities and equipment to handle Plastic Waste safely, may grant registration to the applicant on fulfillment of the conditions as may be laid down in terms of registration. The inspection shall be carried out by the Officer of Board for verifying the submissions of Land and compliance of PWM Rules, 2016 as per format at Annexure-'D'.

State Pollution Control Board shall take a decision on the grant of registration within stipulated time period as prescribed by HEPC. The registration granted under this rule shall initially be valid for a period of 01 year, unless revoked, suspended or canceled and shall subsequently be granted for 03 years. Every application for renewal of registration shall be made atleast 120 days before the expiry of validity of registration certificate.

The power to decide cases of registration for grant / refusal shall be as per following criteria:-

1. Regional Officer may decide the registration under Plastic Waste (Management) Rules, 2016 for units having investment upto 10 crores or CLU upto 01 Acre.
2. Regional Officer shall obtain approval of Nodal Officer, HEPC, Panchkula for projects with investment above 10 crores or CLU Cases more than 01 Acre.

The status of all such registration granted by the Board will be displayed on the website of the Board under the heading "registered producers and brand owners, recyclers and processors, manufacturer under Plastic Waste (Management) Rules 2016".

All the concerned shall ensure the compliance of the above said decision of the Board effectively.

34. **Recommendations :-**

Agenda item 180, 18(S)

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**Installation of 05 Nos Continuous Ambient Air Quality Monitoring Station (CAAQMS) (03 in Faridabad and 2 in Gurugarm in Haryana).**

As per the directions of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, the Central Pollution control Board in Writ Petition No. 13029/1985 titled "MC Mehta Vs. Union of India & Others" submitted a proposal to the Apex Court for installation of 05 Real Time Stations ( 3 in Faridabad and 02 in Gurugram ) in the State of Haryana within the NCR area.

Pursuant to above, in the first review meeting on ' Strengthening of Air Quality Monitoring in NCR Region held in CPCB on 19.12.2016, It was decided that 5 CAAQM Stations( 3 in Faridabad and 02 in Gurugram ) in the NCR region of Haryana be installed.

04 Nos of CAAQMS Stations are operating at Faridabad, Gurugram, Rohtak & Panchkula Districts of Haryana. The Letter of Award has been issued by the Board for installation of another 19 CAAQMS Stations in the Districts of Haryana i.e. Sonipat, Panipat, Rewari (Dharuhera),Bahadurgarh, Kaithal, Karnal,Yamuna Nagar, Gurugram( Manesar), Faridabad, Ambala, Bhiwani, Fatehabad, Hisar, Jind Kurukshetra, Mahendergarh, Mewat, Palwal and Sirsa. The total Award Price for one station is Rs.1.30,00,000/- (taxes and duties extra) which includes both the capital cost as well as Operation and Maintenance for period of 05 years.

Additional 5 CAAQMS (3 in Faridabad and 02 in Gurugram ) are sanctioned by CPCB and the financial assistance for setting up 05 CAAQMS will be done by CPCB through Environment Protection Charges (EPC) funds. CPCB has sanctioned Rs. 7,50,000,00/- ( Rupees Seven Crores Fifty Lakh only) to HSPCB for setting up of five (05) Continuous Ambient Air Quality Monitoring Stations(CAAQMS) in Faridabad and Gurugram (3CAAQMS Faridabad and 02 CAAQMS Gurugram). Total Sanction of Rs. 7,50,000,00/- (Rupees Seven Crores Fifty Lakh only) involves capital cost included O&M cost for 5 years.

The Board has issued letter of award for procurement of 19 CAAQMS after following long procedure. The procedure for e-procurement of CAAQMS includes publications of e-tender, opening of technical bids, opening of

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financial bids and approval of proposal in High Power Purchase Committee. After following the long procedure board has finalized the Procurement of CAAQMS and issued the letter of award vide no HSPCB/SSC/2018/6298 dt. 21.05.2018. The total Award Price for one station is Rs.1.30,00,000/- (taxes and duties extra) which includes both the capital cost as well as Operation and Maintenance for period of 05 years. The rates for purchase of 19 CAAQMS seem to be reasonable. The Board may place repeat order as per Rule of Directorate of Supplies & Disposal, Haryana and para 16 of order no. G.O. No. 2/2/2010-4 I Bil dated 28 May 2010 of Department of Industries and commerce Govt. of Haryana.

#### Rule for Repeat Order

A repeat order should generally be avoided. However following condition has been prescribed by Government for placing the repeat order:-

- (i) Repeat Order can be placed within two months of the date of issue of original supply order.
- (ii) The Value of repeat order shall not exceed the value of the original order.
- (iii) The indenting officer should intimate the reasons as to why the quantity proposed to be covered by repeat order could not be included in the original indent. He should certify that there is no downward trend in prices in the market since the placement of original order.
- (iv) The repeat order cannot be placed where original purchase has been finalized on the basis of short terms quotations or by making spot purchase.
- (v) Repeat order cannot be placed where the lower rates been ignored due to longer delivery period or no submission of tested sample/ test report.
- (vi) Where the quantity has been reduced in the original indent subsequently so as to bring the committee of within the purview of standing purchase committee of lower competence the repeat order shall not be placed.
- (vii) The indenting officer shall have to send requirements within 45 days of the placements of original supply order so as to give 15 days to the Directorate to process the case for placing the repeat order.
- (viii) The procedure laid down in respect of placing original supply order shall equally apply to the repeat orders as well.

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As per Para 16 of order no. G.O. No. 2/2/2010-4 I BII dated 28 May 2010 of Department of Industries and commerce Govt. of Haryana.

16. Repeat Order:

The existing system of placing repeat orders equal to the initially indented quantities with the same firm(s) on the basis of same rates is not a fair practice. As such, it has been decided that, excepting in the case of rate contracts, the repeat orders should not be placed for more than 25% of the quantities involved in the original order. In case the requirements of additional stores are large than 25% of the original order, it should be indented a fresh and go through a competitive tendering process.

It is also pertinent to mention here that 25% of 19 stations is 4.75 whereas Board have to install 05 stations. 4.75 may be considered as 05 stations.

Board may install 05 Nos of additional CAAQMS (3 in Faridabad and 02 in Gurugram ) in addition to already installed 04 Nos. and already sanctioned 19 Nos of stations in Districts of Haryana.

Further, Board may issue the repeat order to Environnement S.A India Pvt. Ltd D-16, 3& 4, TCC Industrial Area, M.I.D.C, Turbe, Navi Mumbai- 400705 India, on same rates and terms & conditions as being followed of procurement of 19 CAAQMS Stations.

This matter is placed before the Board for consideration and approval of above said proposal please.

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
