Minutes of 180th meeting of the Haryana State Pollution Control Board, Panchkula, held at 2.30 P.M. on 08.06.2018 under the Chairmanship of Sh. Ashok Kheterpal, Chairman, Haryana State Pollution Control Board, Panchkula.

The 180th meeting of the Haryana State Pollution Control Board was convened at 2.30 P.M. on 08.06.2018 in its Conference Room under the Chairmanship of Sh. Ashok Kheterpal, Chairman, HSPCB. The list of participants is at **Annexure-I**. Leave of absence was granted to the Members who could not attend the meeting. The Member Secretary of the Board welcomed all the participants and presented the agenda items before the Board. A detailed discussion was held on all the agenda items and the minutes of the meeting are presented as below.

Agenda Item No. 180.1

Confirmation of the minutes of 179th meeting of the Haryana State Pollution Control Board.

Minutes of 179th meeting were confirmed.

Agenda Item No. 180.2

Action taken on the minutes of the 179th meeting of the Haryana State Pollution Control Board held on 28.03.2018.

The Board members were apprised of the action taken on the decisions taken in the 179th meeting and the same were noted.

Agenda Item No. 180.8

Proposed Amendments in Haryana State Pollution Control Board (Group A, B, C and D) Service Regulations, 2004.

The proposal contained in Agenda Note was approved.

Agenda Item No. 180.9

Promotion to the post of Senior Scientist.

The proposal contained in Agenda Note was discussed and it was approved that Dr. P.K.M.K.Das, Scientist 'C' may be promoted to the post of Senior Scientist in the Functional Pay Level (FPL)-14 i.e. Rs. 1,18,500/- (minimum) of 7th Revised Pay Package Formulation (RPPF).

Agenda Item No. 180.10

Increase of Permanent Imprest allotted to all Regional Offices & Laboratories.

The proposal contained in Agenda Note was approved.

Agenda Item No. 180.11

Installation of 22 Manual Ambient Air Quality Monitoring Stations in different Districts of Haryana i.e. Mahendergarh, Bhiwani, Mewat, Rohtak, Sonapat, Rewari, Jhajjar, Panipat, Palwal, Jind and Karnal.

The proposal contained in Agenda Note was approved.

Agenda Item No. 180.12

Imposing Prohibition on installation of new Pyrolysis Plants in the State.

The proposal contained in Agenda Note was approved. However, it was suggested by the Board that the study as proposed in the agenda may be completed within a time

bound manner as soon as possible to avoid the scope of illegal establishment of such type of units in the State.

Agenda Item No. 180.13

Delegation of power for inspection of industries at the time of grant of 1st CTO at the Regional Officers of the Board.

The proposal contained in Agenda Note was approved.

Agenda Item No. 180.14 (S)

Sanction for recruitment of Consultant for a period of six months having expertise in Environmental Science.

The proposal contained in Agenda Note was approved. However, it was also suggested & approved by the Board of Directors that period of engagement of Consultant may be enhanced from six months to one year which may be further extendable for another period on year to year basis of requirement of the Board and performance of the professional.

Agenda Item No. 180.15 (S)

For delegation of power to the ROs for grant/ refusal of authorization cases under, E-waste Management Rules, 2016.

The proposal contained in Agenda Note was approved. However, it was also suggested by the Board of Directors that awareness programmes may also be organized through Workshop / Meetings with Entrepreneurs of relevant field for proper implementation of E-waste (Management) Rules, 2016.

Agenda Item No. 180.16 (S)

Extension of existing stone crushing zone of Khanak, District – Bhiwani.

After detailed discussion, it was decided to defer the matter for next meeting and a detailed report be put up regarding requirement with justification of expansion in existing zone including the details of units operating outside the zone, existing area, gaps/area available in the existing zone, proposed area of expansion, no. of units existing in the proposed zone and proposed number of units to be shifted to expanded zone. Also in addition to this, a detailed plan of new zone may be put up for examination of the matter in the interest of Environment as well as to cope up from existing circumstances.

Agenda Item No. 180.17 (S)

Procedure for grant / refusal of registration cases under, Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016.

The proposal contained in Agenda Note was approved.

Agenda Item No. 180.18 (S)

Installation of 05 Nos Continuous Ambient Air Quality Monitoring Station (CAAQMS) (03 in Faridabad and 2 in Gurugram in Haryana).

The proposal contained in Agenda Note was approved.

Agenda Item No. 180.19 (S)

Proposal for revision of the existing fee structure of Board for obtaining consent to establish and consent to operate fee under Water Act, 1974 and Air Act, 1981 for the various industries / projects / legally constituted bodies / service sector.

Agenda item was approved and the Board agreed with the proposal to forward the same to Government for its consideration and approval. Proposal for revision of the existing fee structure of Board for obtaining consent to establish and consent to operate fee under Water Act, 1974 and Air Act, 1981 for the various industries/projects/ legally constituted bodies/ service sector.

The Board is charging the consent fees/annual consent fees prescribed as per notification no. G.S.R.90/CA6/74/S.64/97 dated 5th December 1997 and amendment vide notification, dated 6th April 1998, dated 25th Jan, 1999, dated 3rd May, 2002, dated 20th September 2002, and dated 4th October, 2007, issued by Government of Haryana, Environment Department, which has been incorporated in Haryana Water (Prevention and Control of Water Pollution) Rules, 1978 notified vide notification no. GSR-125/C.A.6/74/S.64/78 dated 22.12.1978 as amended till date and in Haryana Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Rules 1983 notification no. G.S.R. 73/C.A.14/81/S. 54/83 dated 15.12.1983 as amended till date.

A committee of the officers of the Board was constituted vide order Endst. no. 3907-3911 dated 09.05.2017, for preparing the proposal for revision in the fee structure for obtaining consent to establish and consent to operate under Water Act, 1974 and Air Act, 1981. The proposal prepared by the committee was discussed on 31.05.2018 by the worthy Member Secretary alongwith the officers of Head Office and after incorporating the suggestions the revised proposal was prepared and submitted to the Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) of the Board for deliberation and recommendation. The TAC in its meeting held on 04.06.2018, has agreed with the proposal submitted by the Nodal Officer of the committee and the same has been approved by the competent authority on dated 06.06.2018 which is at **Annexure-1**.

In the proposal **Annexure-A** is revised fee structure proposed for consent to establish/ consent to operate under Water Act, 1974 and Air Act, 1981. The **Annexure-B** of the proposal, consists the comparison of existing fee structure and new fee structure proposed. The **Annexure-C** of the proposal, consists the comparison of the new proposed fee structure with consent fee of other State Pollution Control Boards i.e. Punjab, Rajasthan & Uttar Pradesh. The various aspects which have been taken into account due to which the fee revision is necessitated are given as per **Annexure-D**.

The salient features/recommendations of the committee are outlined as under:-

1. The committee has referred the fee structures of 03 nos. adjacent State Pollution Control Boards i.e. Punjab, Rajasthan & Uttar Pradesh.
2. The committee has pointed out the various points of justification required for the revision in the existing fee structure, which is submitted as per **Annexure-D**.
3. In the existing fee structure the Consent to Establish & Consent to Operate for the industries have been prescribed under two categories i.e. for highly

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polluting and other than highly polluting except the units where the fee has been specifically prescribed. By office orders, the Board is charging CTE/CTO fee from the Red category units as highly polluting units and from the orange & green category units as other than highly polluting units. The committee has proposed the separate fee slabs for Red, Orange & Green category of industries as per categorization done by CPCB.

4. In the existing fee structure, the Board is charging Consent to Establish fee from various units either under Water Act or Air Act, whereas the categorization of the industries made by the CPCB which is being followed by the HSPCB, is under both the Acts i.e. Water Act & Air Act. So the committee has proposed the Consent to Establish fee from the various units under both Acts. The one of the State Pollution Control Board out of 03 nos. PCBs whose fee structure has been referred is already charging Consent to Establish fee under both Acts.
5. In the existing fee structure, the highest fee slab is above 100 crore. The investment cost of the industries has been increased many fold due to increase in the value of land, cost of construction and cost of plant & machinery with latest technology, since the last revision of fee i.e. in the year 1997. So, like the fee structures of the referred PCBs, the committee has proposed the fee slabs beyond investment of 100 crores also i.e. 100 to 200 crore, 200 to 500 crore, 500 to 1000 crore and above 1000 crore. Similarly, the lower fee slabs for investment upto 2 Lacs, 2 to 10 Lacs and 10 to 25 Lacs, have been merged in the proposed slab of upto 25 Lacs for charging the Consent to Operate fee.
6. The committee has proposed the 50% increase in the existing fee structure for Red & Orange category prescribed/ followed for Consent to Establish for various units upto the investment slab of 100 crore. In the investment slab of 100 to 200 crore, 200 to 500 crore, 500 to 1000 crore & above 1000 crore, the increase in Consent to Establish fee, have been proposed 30%, 60%, 100% & 200% respectively, of the existing fee prescribed for the investment slab above 100 crore. For the Green Category, the fee proposed is approx. 75% of the Consent to Establish fee proposed for the Orange category of industries.
7. In the existing, Consent to Operate fee structure for Red & Orange category, the two fee structures have been prescribed i.e. for the first year and for the subsequent years. The committee has proposed the single fee structure for charging the Consent to Operate fee i.e. same for the first year and subsequent years. The committee has not proposed any increase in the Consent to Operate fee upto the investment slab of 100 crore, however the Consent to Operate fee prescribed for the first year in the existing fee structure have been proposed for the subsequent years also. In the investment slab of 100 to 200 crore, 200 to 500 crore, 500 to 1000 crore & above 1000 crore, the increase in Consent to Operate fee, have been proposed 30%, 60%, 100% & 200% respectively, of the existing fee prescribed for the first year for the investment slab above 100 crore. For the Green Category, the Consent to Operate fee proposed is approx. 75% of the fee proposed for the Orange category of industries.

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8. In the existing fee structure the separate fee slabs are prescribed under Water Act & Air Act for mining activities. The committee has proposed the same fee slabs under both Acts, as per existing fee slab prescribed under Haryana Water Rules and the Consent to Operate fee prescribed for the first year under Water Rules is proposed for the consecutive years also under both Acts i.e. Water Act & Air Act. The same slabs and fee has also been proposed for charging the CTE fee under both the Acts.
9. In the existing fee structure no separate fee slabs are prescribed for Hotels, Health Care Facilities, and Construction Projects. The Committee has proposed the separate fee slabs for charging Consent to Establish & Consent to Operate fee from such category of units considering the categorization of industries by CPCB.
10. As per existing fee structure different fee slabs have been prescribed for Stone Crushers, Brick Kilns, Hot Mix Plants, Pulverisers & Screening plants under Water Act or Air Act. The committee has proposed the same fee slabs for all these category of units for charging Consent to Establish and Consent to Operate under both Acts.

The proposal for revision of fee for obtaining consent to establish and consent to operate under Water Act, 1974 and Air Act, 1981 as per Annexure-A is submitted for approval of the Board so that the same can be submitted to Government for approval and notification

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Annexure-I

Proposal for revision of the existing fee structure of Board for obtaining consent to establish and consent to operate fee under Water Act, 1974 and Air Act, 1981 for the various industries/projects/ legally constituted bodies/ service sector.

As per orders dated 04.05.2017 issued vide endst. no. 3907-3911 dated 09.05.2017, a committee of the officers of the Board was constituted for preparing the proposal for revision in the fee structure for obtaining consent to establish and consent to operate fees under Water Act, 1974 and Air Act, 1981. Also CPCB vide letter No. B-29012/IPC-Vi/2016-17/24758 dated 20.03.2017 advised the Pollution Control Boards/Committees to follow the definition of, The Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) as per, The Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises Development Act, 2006 (MSMED Act, 2006) for charging the consent fees. The committee comprises of following members:

Presently the Board is charging the consent fees/annual consent fees as per notification no. G.S.R.90/CA6/74/S.64/97 dated 5th December 1997 and amendment vide notification, dated 6th April 1998, dated 25th Jan, 1999, dated 3rd May, 2002, dated 20th September 2002, and dated 4th October, 2007, which is incorporated in Haryana Water (Prevention and Control of Water Pollution) Rules, 1978 notified vide notification no. GSR-125/C.A.6/74/S.64/78 dated 22.12.1978 (Amended till date) under Water Act (Prevention and Control of Pollution), 1974 and in Haryana Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Rules 1983 notification no. G.S.R. 73/C.A.14/81/S. 54/83 dated 15.12.1983 (amended till date) under Air Act (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 of Environment Department Govt. of Haryana

A proposal of fee revision was prepared by Committee and submitted for consideration of Technical Advisory Committee. The recommendations of TAC meeting was circulated vide letter no. 4076-88 dated 20.04.2018. In the TAC meeting it was decided to compare the fee structures of the other State Pollution Control Boards and provide the proper justification for revision in the existing consent fee structure.






10. As per existing fee structure different fee slabs have been prescribed for Stone Crushers, Brick Kilns, Hot Mix Plants, Pulverisers & Screening plants under Water Act or Air Act. The committee has proposed the same fee slabs for all these category of units for charging Consent to Establish and Consent to Operate under both Acts.

The revised proposal is submitted as per Annexure-A. In the Annexure-B, the comparison of existing fee structure and proposed fee structure has been done. In Annexure-C, the comparison of the proposed fee structure have been made with other State Pollution Control Boards i.e. Punjab, Rajasthan & Uttar Pradesh. As per Annexure-D, the various aspects have been submitted due to which the fee revision is necessitated.

1. The investment costs of industries/units for calculating CTE/CTO fees will be calculated considering investment in Land, Building, Plant and Machinery and other fixed assets (Non Depreciated Value)
2. All units shall apply for renewal for CTO before 90 days of the expiry of the previous consent. If the industrial units/projects fails to apply before 90 days of the expiry of the previous consent and apply 60 days before the expiry of previous consent, the unit shall have to pay additional consent fee @ 50% of the consent fee notified. Subsequently if the unit fails to apply before 60 days of the expiry of the previous consent and applies 30 days before the expiry of previous consent, then the unit have to pay additional consent fee @ 100% of the consent fee notified. If the unit fails to apply 30 days before the expiry of the previous consent, the unit have to pay additional consent fee @ 200% of the consent fee notified. Thereafter, if unit fails to apply before 90 days of expiry of the previous consent, the unit have to pay additional fee @ 300% of the consent fee notified.

The revision of existing fee structure as per Haryana Water (Prevention and Control of Water Pollution) Rules 1978 notified vide notification no. GSR-125/C.A.6/74/S.64/78 dated 22.12.1978 (Amended till date) under Water Act (Prevention and Control of Pollution) 1974 and as per Haryana Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Rules 1983 notification no. G.S.R. 73/C.A.14/81/S. 54/83 dated 15.12.1983 (amended till date) under Air Act (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 of Environment Department Govt. of Haryana, is necessitated considering the following aspects:

1. The fee structure of the Board was previously revised in the year 1997/1999. The fee is not revised for last 20 years and during this period the Price Index has been increased from 159.1 (January 1997) to 247.86 (January 2018).
2. The Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Cess Act, 1977 has been abolished after coming into existence of GST Act, 2017. The revenues from the water cess collected under Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Cess Act, 1977 were the major share of the income of the Board which was 05 to 06 Crores annually which is now not a part of income of the Board.
3. The Board has been expended many fold since 1997 and still in the process of expansion. Moreover as per the need of the time the Board is increasing its IT set up, Laboratories, Technical/ testing instruments/ monitoring devices.
4. The CPCB has issued the directions under section 18(1)(b) of the Water Act, 1974 and Air Act 1981 vide letter no. B-290129/ESS(CPA)/2015-16/8571 dated 07.03.2016, wherein the industries have been categorised as Red, Orange, Green and White based on the range of pollution index. The white category of industries have been exempted from the consent management. Therefore, separate fee slabs for charging the consent fees under Red, Orange and Green category are necessitated.
5. The Board is in the process of constructing the residential building for the employees of the board, office building and strengthening of laboratories, which will need additional funds.
6. A number of employees of the board will be retired in the coming years and additional funds will be required for their pension and other liabilities.

It is pertinent to mention here that the Hon'ble Court in its order dasted 04.06.2018 has not barred the Pollution Control Board for consideration of the case of promotion of Dr. P.K.M.K. Das to the post of Senior Scientist.

Respected Sir,

With due respect and humble submission it is stated that I have served the Haryana State Pollution Control Board for almost 3 decades and have an unblemished service record. At the fag end of my career, when I was eligible to be promoted as Senior Scientist, my rights are being frustrated by completely ignoring my candidature on account of a unilateral decision taken to promote Sh. P.K.M.K Das. Hence, I submit the following facts for the kind consideration of your good self:-

1. As a matter of record, upon being appointed as Senior Scientific Assistant, I joined the Board on 21.08.1989, while Sh. P.K.M.K Das joined on 23.08.1989. Hence, for all intents and purposes and in terms of Rule 11 of the Haryana State Pollution Control Board (Group A,B & C) Service Regulations, 2004, on the principle of continuous length of service, Sh. P.K.M.K Das is deemed to be junior

to me. It may not be out of place to state here that even at the time of joining service, Sh. P.K.M.K Das had been allowed to join after the expiry of seven days period as prescribed in the appointment letter. Ergo, an illegality in the appointment of Sh. P.K.M.K Das crept at the first instance.

2. The first and only tentative seniority list of Scientist B in the State Pollution Control Board was circulated on 23.11.2011, wherein Sh. P.K.M.K Das had erroneously been shown at serial No. 6, while I was placed at serial No. 7. Aggrieved by the wrong placement assigned to me, I submitted detailed objections on 08.12.2011, against the tentative seniority list. The records would reveal that till date the tentative seniority list has not been finalised and the objections submitted by me have not been considered and decided.
3. The dispute with respect to the inter-se seniority has remained unresolved and on account of this fact Sh. P.K.M.K Das and I were both promoted on the same day as Scientist C, i.e 04.04.2012.
4. On 28.02.2018, Sh. Dinesh Kumar superannuated and the post of Senior Scientist was available. Therefore I

submitted a representation dated 21.02.2018. No decision on a representation has been taken so far. However, I was surprised to come across the agenda for the proceeding scheduled on 08.06.2018, wherein the decision has already been taken to promote Sh. P.K.M.K Das as Senior Scientist without deciding the seniority and objections filed by me against the tentative seniority.

5. I have obtained information under the RTI Act, and it reveals from the noting sheet pertaining to the issue of promotion to the post of Senior Scientist that on account of non-finalisation of the draft rules the process was stopped till finalization of amendments in rules . However, surprisingly on 07.05.2018 without the issue of draft rules being finalised, the process was re initiated. The noting sheet is further throw light on the following facts, which are per se incorrect:-

- a) The noting sheet has been prepared on an assumption that Sh. P.K.M.K Das is the seniormost officer in the cadre, which fact is completely incorrect as no decision with respect to the finalisation of seniority has been taken yet. Furthermore, Sh. P.K.M.K Das cannot be deemed to

be senior until and unless the objections submitted by me are considered and decided.

b) The noting sheet further reflects that it has been stated that the complaint received from the CM window grievance against Sh. P.K.M.K Das was examined and it is the view of the Board that the officer is not at fault. It may be submitted here that the final decision is to be taken by the competent authority at the level of the Hon'ble Chief Minister and the Board is not in a position to grant a clean chit to him. Furthermore, an enquiry on a complaint submitted through the CM window itself is serious enough for ignoring the claims of Sh. P.K.M.K Das and more over no charge sheet has been issued so far after placing him under suspension.

c) Further it has also been transpired from the noting sheets that actually the number of cases where in pendency / delay^{is} 52, but the number of cases delayed have been shown as 28 only, which shows correct information has not been provided by the branch .

- d) It is further stated in the noting sheet that merely because the post of Senior Scientist has been created, final amendment of the rules is not required. The same position continued to exist prior to May, 2018 and the matter had been deferred on this account but the sudden change in stand now taken is also unwarranted.

Apart from the aforementioned facts, the noting sheet is completely silent about certain very vital aspects which appeared to have been deliberately suppressed. Firstly, as per information made available under the RTI Act, it transpires that a complaint from the Director General, State Vigilance Bureau was also received against Sh. P.K.M.K Das having serious allegation of financial irregularities which has deliberately not been processed by the Board, so far. Secondly, the noting sheets are conspicuously silent about suspension 4-5 times on account of serious lapse and six chargesheets, which have been issued to Sh. P.K.M.K Das during the currency of his service. Thirdly, the noting sheet deliberately does not put forth a panel of three persons who can be considered for promotion to the post of Senior Scientist as the officials concerned are aware that the other two

persons who can be made part of the panel have a clean and unblemished service record and would certainly stay in a march over Sh. P.K.M.K Das in terms of seniority as well as merit. These facts clearly reveal that several material facts have been deliberately suppressed.

6. Since, no action was being taken on my representation and the issue of seniority had also not been decided, I was constrained to approach the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court by filing CWP No. 14631 of 2018, wherein notice of motion has been issued for 13.07.2018, with the specific direction that promotion, if any would be subject to the outcome of the said petition.
7. Pertinently, in para No. 11 of my writ petition I have disclosed the misleading facts recorded in the noting sheets and in para No. 12 of the writ petition details of service record of Sh. P.K.M.K Das, including the aforementioned six chargesheets have also been disclosed in a tabulated form. A copy of the order dated 04.06.2018 is enclosed herewith. Suffice it to say that the Board will have to respond to the aforementioned facts in case a decision is taken to promote Sh. P.K.M.K Das on 08.06.2018.

In normal circumstances, any officer facing enquiry can at best be considered for promotion by resorting to seal the cover process. However, in the present case it appears that entire process of service jurisprudence has been circumvented with the sole objective of granting preferential treatment to Sh. P.K.M.K Das. The fact that no panel has been prepared and a tainted officer is being preferred over officers with clean service record itself reflects that something wrong is being projected and carried forward in the Board.

In light of the aforementioned circumstances and in order to protect the interest of the Board I have preferred the present representation, without prejudice to my rights, seeking for the kind indulgence of your good self to reject the proposal for promotion of Sh. P.K.M.K Das to the post of Senior Scientist in the meeting scheduled on 08.06.2018 until and unless the complete service record of all eligible employees, including myself are placed before the members of the board and the matter is considered strictly in terms of seniority and merit .

Strengthening of Haryana State Pollution Control Board with additional Regional Offices, Zonal Offices and supervisory post in the rank of Chief Environmental Engineer in Head Office.

It is submitted that the Board has been working with the sanctioned capacity of 299 officials in different ranks as per the sanctioned strength with 12 Regional Offices under the control of Regional Officer with the field officials in the rank of Assistant Environmental Engineers, Junior Environmental Engineers and Scientist 'B'. It has been observed in different fora that with the increased load of work and responsibilities the Regional Offices which are currently holding jurisdiction of (mostly) 2-3 districts are not able to deliver the results efficiently and they need to be strengthened with additional Regional Offices (with at least one Regional Office per District) as has been done in all other States.

This matter has been discussed with the Government at the level of Additional Chief Secretary (Environment), Hon'ble Minister of Environment Haryana. Chairman and Members of Public Accounts Committee of Vidhan Sabha of State of Haryana in a meeting also felt the necessity of immediately strengthening of Board by providing more regions and monitoring officers and staff. There is need to establish regional office in each district with regular set up of 3 Assistant Environmental Engineers, 1 Junior Environmental Engineer, 1 Scientist 'B', 1 Assistant, 1 Clerk, 1 Peon & 1 Field Attendant as existing in other Regional Offices. It has also been felt that for monitoring these Regional Offices the Zonal Offices are also required to be set up in the lines of Divisional Commissioner rates established in the State of Haryana with one Senior Environmental Engineer level officer as its Head who may be assisted by 1 Assistant Environmental Engineer, 1 Deputy Superintendent, 1 Assistant, 2 Clerks & 1 Peon. It was also felt that there should be a post of Chief Environmental Engineer at Head Office level to effectively monitor the Zonal Offices and Regional Offices so that the Board can deliver its functions appropriately.

A detailed list of proposed additional manpower for creation of 12 more Regional Offices (with one Regional Office in each District of Haryana and with 2 Regional Offices each in Faridabad and Gurugram where the issues of severe air pollution and more number of industries are observed), 6 Zonal Offices (in Hisar, Ambala, Karnal, Faridabad, Gurugram and Rohtak) following the lines of Divisional Commissioners with the similar jurisdictions and a Chief Environmental Engineer at Headquarter of Haryana State Pollution Control Board has been placed below for consideration of the Board.

It is proposed that the Board may consider the above proposal and accord its in-principle approval for the same.
