Proceedings of review meeting for action taken for river action plan by RRC through VC held on 21.03.2025 at 12:00 Noon with SESTFs/ DSTFs in conference room of HSPCB, C-11, Sector-6, Panchkula.

The meeting was held RRC through VC held on 21.03.2025 at 12:00 Noon with SESTFs/ DSTFs in conference room of HSPCB, C-11, Sector-6, Panchkula. The list of participants is enclosed as **Annexure**.

Right at the outset, Sh. Pardeep Kumar, IAS, Member Secretary, HSPCB welcomed all the participants and asked Sh. JP Singh, SEE to discuss the agenda. Thereafter, the action taken was reviewed one by one for all the SESTFs and the proceedings / action taken are given as under:-

	1. The drain quality has improved a lot of BOD level has been at 35 mg/l. But RO is not reporting the same. It indicated improper sampling. RO was endorsed to collect one sample continuously for a week at different times of day. 2. 16 points found non-complying. 3. 6 tankers impounded by RTA. 4. Closure recommended against M/s SK Enterprise 5. Prosecution recommended against M/s RS Agro

	1. RO informed for having appointed a committee but it was clarified that ATR on ground where pollution is to be control only will be recorded on ATR. Further, they were advised to maintain the improvement in drain water quality. 2. 5 new untapped point identified
3.	Sonipat
	1. EC has been recommended of Rs. 61 lacs on HSIIDC Barhi and Rs. 58 lacs on HSIIDC, Kundli. 2. Recommendation dt. 17.02.2025 for closure order against M/s Chandan Wood Product, Village & Post Office Ashwarpur Bahalgarh, Distt. Sonipat has been sent. HO Branch is requested to expedite the same.
4.	Kurukshetra
	1. Representative of Session Judge and SP were not present. 2. Plausible ATR not submitted.
5.	Panchkula
	1. RO Panchkula has issued speaking order against 5 nos. illegal units. But closer order not issued so far. 2. SESTF was reminded of the muddy water in river Ghaggar due to

	screening plants. They asked to check and report for the same.
6.	Karnal
	1. Representative of Session Judge and SP were not present. 2. RO Karnal recommended for closure. RO was asked to collect land details. If some officer does not provide timely information then his name be informed immediately placing before RRC.
7.	Yamuna Nagar
	The drain quality worsened. So action be taken proactively.
8.	Rohtak
	1. Representative of DC, SP and Session Judge were not present. 2. RO was advised to utilize power of district administration DC/ SP who are the highest authority of District. So noting remain for not to take action. Nil ATR can be attributed to no action or no pollution.
9.	Sirsa
	1. Representative of DC, SP and Session Judge were not present. 2. 5 points of domestic untreated effluent of village Dhanipartap, Bhuda Bhana, Mushahi Bwala, Panihari have been diverted. 3. 1 point of Irrigation Department has been identified.
10.	Jind
	Nil, as there is no industrial effluent discharge into river Ghaggar.
11.	Nuh
	RO was asked to report immediately for ATR and water cell shall immediately put in consolidated ATR. So, it will save time and the time duration of RRC/ SESTF review meeting shall shorten.

	<p>1. ADC and DSP were not present.</p> <p>2. 03 nos. of closure order i.e.</p> <p>i. M/s Amar Garden, Kaithal</p> <p>ii. M/s Celebration Farm, , Kaithal</p> <p>3. M/s Shiv Shakti Misthan Bhandar, Kaithal, which discharging untreated effluent into Geong Drain at Kaithal, closure order was issued by the Head Office and Hon'ble District & Session court, Kaithal issued the stay order. Sh. Rajiv Puri, Representative of Session Judge was requested be get this case dismissed as Lower Courts cannot take cognizance of the statutory orders of SPCB. HO branch to expedite the case.</p> <p>2. RO was advised to get the complainant replaced in cases files by the Sh. Sachin AEE expeditiously with help of representative of District Judge.</p>

	<p>1. Representative of DC, SP and Session Judge were not present.</p> <p>2. No plausible ATR submitted.</p> <p>The matter of illegal industries operating after issuance of closure orders was raised up with Sh. Vikas Grewal, Scientist-B, Gurugram as it has been reported as lying closed. He was directed to given the copy of letter issued to Electricity Department and names of defaulting officers immediately.</p>

	<p>1. The ATR is nill in Faridabad.</p> <p>RC Gola enquired whether he can file a complaint in court. It was clarified that as an individied he will have to give 60 days notice to SPCB and</p>

	<p>subsequently, if SPCB do not file prosecution then he can file. Further, being member of SESTF he can refer any violation to concerned authority and they are bound to act. If they do not act/ shield then SESTF can report this to RRC for action against the concerned authority/ officer. He was requested to get the prosecution action expedited in district court for creation of deterrent regarding environment violations.</p> <p>2. 100 MLD STP, Prtapgarh :- Calculation leaving of Environmental Compensation of Rs. 3,05,00,000/- has been sent to Head Office vide letter dated 19-02-2025. The concerned branches in HSPCB should get it expedited. The EC on drain to be imposed directly by RO.</p>

Member Secretary, HSPCB again requested all the participants to work in a mission mode work to achieve the targets given by the Hon'ble NGT regarding rejuvenation of the rivers of Haryana and report be submitted as soon as possible for the actions completed / done in the districts and also recommend actions against violating persons. The GOI is writing again that the quality of drains is not impressing and SESTFs has to act as per mandate given by Hon'ble NGT.

Sh. Pracheta Singh, CJM opined that successful prosecution for environmental violations shall be of great help for efficacy of abatement and control activities. So, he suggested that representative of District Judge should also be taken into loop while file prosecutions. The RRC committee agrees to the suggestion. RO should follow the advice.
