Sub: Clarifications on installation of OCEMS and requirement of environmental Clearance for CBWTFs – reg.

26/12

Sir,

This has reference to a representation received from CBWTF Association of India, raising issues in installation of OCEMS for notified parameters and requirement of Environmental Clearance for upgradation of incinerator. To address the issues, CPCB convened a meeting with Association of CBWTFs on 14.11.2019 along with officials of SPCBs from Punjab, Maharashtra, Andhra Pradesh, Rajasthan and Gujarat States.

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Points of discussion are given below;

OCEMS based compliance reporting is essential for monitoring by SPCBs/PCCS, for which SPCBs are required specify parameters for OCEMS. However, in view of high cost of OCEMS, SPCBs may consider adding parameters for OCEMS in gradual manner.

2. With regard to requirement of EC without increasing capacity it was clarified that, Para 7(ii) of EIA notification, 2006 stipulates that Environmental Clearance (EC) would apply in: (a) for expansion with increase in production capacity beyond the capacity for which earlier EC was granted; and (b) for modernization of an existing unit with increase in total consented production capacity. Upgradation/Modernization of incinerator is necessary to comply with revised emission standards.

In view of above and as per the discussions held with Association, I am directed to inform that SPCBs may consider the following;

- (i) CBWTFs may install CEMS analyzers for temperature of primary and secondary combustion chambers, CO, CO<sub>2</sub> and PM for monitoring compliance pertaining to temperature, combustion efficiency and Particulate Matter. CEMS for parameters like HCl and Mercury may not be insisted at this stage and for which the operator of facility shall submit manual monitoring results periodically.
- (ii) In case existing CBWTF desires to upgrade/modernize incinerator without enhancing consented treatment capacity; CBWTFs may not require Environmental clearance. However, clarification from MoEF&CC would be required in other cases.
