Sr. Env. Engineer (HQ) For Member Secretary Proceedings of review meeting for action taken for river action plan by RRC through VC held on 14.8.2025 with SESTFs/ DSTFs in conference room of HSPCB, C-11, Sector-6, Panchkula.

The meeting was held by RRC through VC held on 17.07.2025 with SESTFs/DSTFs in HSPCB, C-11, Sector-6, Panchkula. The VC meeting could not be completed due to network failure.

Right at the outset, Sh. Pardeep Kumar, IAS, Member Secretary, HSPCB welcomed all the participants and briefed that the matter of river pollution is on high priority with state Govt. as well as centre Govt. So everyone has to work in mission mode and casual approach shall be viewed seriously on part of execution agencies. The SESTFs have to closely watch and report such casual approach to RRC for Govt. A template (as minimum) for report /agenda of SESTF meeting has been circulated as guideline. Thereafter, he asked Sh. JP Singh, SEE to discuss the agenda. The action taken was reviewed one by one for all the SESTFs and the proceedings / action taken are given as under.

The most of ROs/ SESTFs have not sent information on required performa on one reason or others. But the reasons given by ROs during the meeting are not acceptable. The report must be submitted and its duty of concerned ROs to ensure sending timely report on performa. Member Secretary, HSPCB exhorted all the officers of SESTFs that achievement/ failures of the concerned period should be reported along with names of concerned defaulting officers. They must be pointed out what is expected from them and what they have not done. The NGT has given very specific directions for writing responsibility in ACRs of the concerned officers and also to take action against violators and those who shield them. So, all the SESTFs were directed to send report by 18.08.2025 for this meeting, failing which it will be presumed as denied. SESTFs have to report for all the columns of the template with whatever information available with them. The ground reality has to be recorded and reported. Any violation reported by 3rd party to RRC shall adversely be construed for SESTF. All must note that there is no point that we portray before Govt. that no improvement can take place vis-vis water pollution.
