DIRECTIONS FOR IMPLEMENTATION UNDER GRAP

- Sub : Directions for Implementation of Graded Response Action Plan (GRAP) in Delhi and NCR-Steps to be taken - Reg.
- Ref : Order of Sub Committee of Commission for Air Quality Management in NCR and Adjoining Areas (CAQM) on GRAP dated 28.10.2021 and Lr of this Office dated 19.10.2021.

The undersigned is directed to refer to the order issued by the Sub Committee of Commission for Air Quality Management in NCR and Adjoining Areas (CAQM) on Graded Response Action Plan (GRAP) dated 28.10.2021, and convey its directions for implementation of the following actions under 'Very Poor' Category, in addition to the steps listed under 'Poor' to 'Moderate AQI' category, already issued by this office vide its Lr dated 19.10.2021, by all the agencies concerned, in the NCR Districts of Haryana with immediate effect.

- Mechanical/vacuum-based sweeping of roads to be carried out daily.
- Ensure water sprinkling along with use of dust suppressants (at least every alternate day) on roads to arrest road dust especially at hotspots, heavy traffic corridors, vulnerable areas (before peak hours) and proper disposal of dust collected in designated sites/landfills.
- Regular inspection for strict enforcement of dust control measures must be ensured at construction sites.
- Ensure uninterrupted power supply to discourage the use of Generator sets.
- Stop use of diesel generator sets [except for emergency purposes (Annexure I)].
- Enhance parking fees by 3-4 times.
- Increase bus and metro services by augmenting contract buses and increasing frequency of service
- Stop use of coal/firewood in hotels and open eateries

In addition to the above, the citizens have also been advised to take actions to prevent air pollution, as below, which may be given wide publicity for their information and necessary action, through various IEC activities possible, in your jurisdiction.

- Residential Welfare Associations and individual house owners to provide electric heaters during winter to security staff to avoid open burning by them.
- Keeping PUC certificates of vehicles up to date.
- Keeping engines of cars/bikes/scooters properly tuned.
- Maintaining proper air pressure in tires of cars/bikes/scooters
- Adherence to lane driving
- Optimize use of private vehicles

- g. Not disposing waste /garbage in the open spaces
- h. Avoid dust generating construction activities during months of October to January, if possible.
- i. Reporting air pollution activities through SAMEER App, social media platforms and other public grievance portals

Further, it is also advised that all Departments / Agencies, HSPCB field offices and District Administration concerned shall disseminate the information about air pollution levels and create awareness among citizens regarding steps to minimize air pollution.

The above directions may be strictly complied with till further orders and the action taken in this regard may be sent after seven days.
