STONE CRUSHING UNIT : STANDARDS FOR SUSPENDED PARTICULATE MATTER

The standards consist of two parts:

i) Implementation of the following pollution control measures:

1. Dust containment cum suppression system for the equipment.
2. Construction of wind breaking walls.
3. Construction of the metalled roads within the premises.
4. Regular cleaning and wetting of the ground within the premises.
5. Growing of a green belt along the periphery.

ii) Quantitative standard for the SPM

The suspended particulate matter measured between 3 to 10 metres from any process equipment of a stone crushing unit shall not exceed $600 \mu\text{g}/\text{m}^3$
