**Sub: Testing of samples collected by field officers-reg.**

With reference to the subject cited above, it has been observed that, in certain cases, some of the Laboratory Incharges, who have been given additional charge of field duty, collect samples from the field units and get them tested by themselves, thereby acting both as Collector of samples as well as Analysts of the samples.

This is not an acceptable procedure as it violates the basic principles of confidentiality and impartiality and violates the provisions of any standardized procedure of laboratory testing requirements.

In view of above, it is hereby directed that any Laboratory Incharge/official holding the additional charge of any field units, shall ensure that the samples collected by him/her shall not be tested in his/her own laboratory and invariably be tested in any of the other laboratories.
